

3. During the term of the conditional license, Applicant will submit to any testing requested by the Board, its staff or stewards, including, but not limited to, blood, breath, saliva, hair strand/shaft, or hair follicle, for the detection of alcohol and/or controlled substances. Applicant can expect requests for testing two times per month. The testing and analysis of such testing for alcohol and/or controlled substances shall be performed at the expense of the Board and in such manner and by such person or persons as may be selected by the Board in its sole discretion.
4. Applicant shall remain in compliance with the guidelines of the Winners' Foundation.
5. Upon successful compliance with the terms of the conditional license for a period of six months from the date of license issuance, and in the absence of any new grounds for license denial, Applicant shall be eligible, upon application, for issuance of an apprentice jockey license.
