

# COMPLAINT

The CHRB hereby files a complaint against **Mike Pender** for violation of CHRB Rule **1843(A)(D)/1887(A)**. The person named in this complaint holds a license as a **Trainer**, license number **282284 02/2013**. The offense alleged occurred on or about **September 26, 2010** and is as follows:

**On September 26, 2010, the horse "Benecia" trained by Mike Pender was post race tested (Sample # F07348) after finishing 1<sup>st</sup> in the 9<sup>th</sup> race at Fairplex Park. Sample #F07348 was tested by U.C. Davis Laboratories and found to contain the Class 3 Prohibited Drug Substance Indomethacin. Trainer Pender declined to have a split sample tested.**

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 19420, 19440, and CHRB Rules, the stewards are empowered to impose penalties for violation of any provision of the CHRB Rules. Such penalties may consist of suspension of any license, fines, and exclusion from all racing enclosures under the jurisdiction of the Board or by any combination of these penalties.

The CHRB hereby files a complaint against **Mike Pender** for violation of CHRB Rule **1859.5**. The person named in this complaint holds a license as a **Trainer**, license number **282284 02/2013**. The offense alleged occurred on or about **September 26, 2010** and is as follows:

**The Official Blood Sample # F07348 taken on September 26, 2010 at the LA County Fair Race Meet was reported by Scott Stanley of U.C. Davis to contain the Class III prohibited drug substance Indomethacin. This sample was taken from the horse "Benecia" which ran in the 9<sup>th</sup> race finishing 1<sup>st</sup>. The trainer of record is Michael Pender. Under Rule 1859.5 (Disqualification upon positive test finding) the horse "Benecia" shall be moved from 1<sup>st</sup> place to last place (9<sup>th</sup>) and the purse will be forfeited.**

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 19420, 19440, and CHRB Rules, the stewards are empowered to impose penalties for violation of any provision of the CHRB Rules. Such penalties may consist of suspension of any license, fines, and exclusion from all racing enclosures under the jurisdiction of the Board or by any combination of these penalties.
