Driver Richard Wojcio, who drove “Dusty Colors” in the First Race on Friday July 20, 2007, is hereby fined the sum of One Hundred (\$100) Dollars for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered – Driving with Foot Out of Stirrup/Urging by Contact).

The above ruling was issued after Wojcio was contacted by phone and accepted the penalty. He understands future penalties for similar violations will result in stiffer fines.
