06-05-08<sup>2</sup> **RULING NO. 16 – GLEASON**

In the Matter of:  
Authorized Agent **PATRICK GLEASON**

Having now paid the outstanding fine imposed in the stipulated agreement with the California Horse Racing Board, Patrick Gleason is hereby restored to good standing and Pacific Racing Association ruling #27, dated January 28, 2007, which suspended Mr. Gleason for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1532 (Payment of Fines) is set aside.

The above ruling was issued after the stewards received word from the Paymaster of Purses that Gleason had deposited sufficient funds to pay the fine imposed in the 2006 stipulated agreement.

06-05-08<sup>3</sup> **RULING NO. 17 – CALVARIO**

Trainer **MANUEL R. CALVARIO** is hereby suspended for failure to abide by the terms of a financial agreement with Pedro Mercado which constitutes a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Manuel R. Calvario are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after Calvario failed to live up to promises, both written and verbal, stating he would make payments to former jockey Pedro Mercado. Pedro was injured while riding one of Manny's horses and some of the outstanding bills were charged to Mercado.

06-05-08<sup>4</sup> **LATE SCRATCH – Fifth Race – REFUND**

#3 FROM ABOVE, trained by Frances Henderson, was scratched on the recommendation of track veterinarian Heather Kerr, D.V.M., as the field neared the starting gate when Dr. Kerr stated the horse was off in the left front. On Vet's list. The refund totaled \$8,496.32.

06-05-08<sup>5</sup> **LATE SCRATCH – Sixth Race – REFUND**

#10 EXCESSIVE FUN, trained by Jerry Fanning, was scratched on the recommendation of Dr. Kerr after the horse was injured while being fractious in the starting gate. On

Vet's list. The refund amounted to \$185,568.16.

06-05-08<sup>6</sup> **STEWARDS' INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – Seventh Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to determine the cause of an accident at the 1/8 which saw #5 ROYAL SIERRA fall, dislodging jockey Russell Baze. #7 SEPARATE INTEREST, ridden by Jorge Herrera, ducked from the fallen horse and broke through the inside turf rail unseating Herrera. #1 OUTSIDE DINING, ridden by Francisco Duran, was eased around the accident but eventually crossed the finish line.

After a thorough review the stewards affirmed the original order of finish. Tapes showed, and Dr. Kerr confirmed, that ROYAL SIERRA went wrong at the 1/8 and fell after suffering a catastrophic injury to the left front (disarticulated ankle). No other horses contributed to ROYAL SIERRA's problems. The mare was euthanized at the scene.

SEPARATE INTEREST did not suffer any serious consequences from the incident. Jockey Jorge Herrera had a forehead contusion and a bloody nose. Russell Baze suffered a mild concussion and was removed from his remaining mount.

06-06-08<sup>1</sup> **RULING NO. 18 – BELLASIS**

Trainer **TIM BELLASIS**, who started the horse **GRECIAN SPUR**, winner of the fifth race at Bay Meadows Race Course on May 9, 2008, is fined the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Phenylbutazone in excess of permitted level – 6.01 ng/ml).

The above ruling was issued after Tim met with the stewards. He was at a loss to explain the high reading because he treated the horse the same as he did the previous outing when the bute level was 1.7 mcg/ml. Apparently, his treatment program was altered with or without his knowledge. Tim understood his responsibility as the trainer of record and accepted the penalty.

06-06-08<sup>2</sup> **RULING NO. 19 – CALVARIO**

Trainer **Manuel Calvario**, having now resolved the outstanding financial obligation to Pedro Mercado, is hereby restored to good standing and Pacific Racing Association ruling #17, dated June 5, 2008, suspending Mr. Calvario for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility) is set aside.

The foregoing ruling was released after Calvario appeared this morning with cash in hand to resolve his financial difficulties.

06-06-08<sup>4</sup> **STEWARDS' INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE – Second Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to review an incident at the ¼ pole which saw jockey Juan Ochoa become separated from his mount, #1 GOLDEN ACTION. After a thorough review the stewards affirmed the original order of finish.

Tapes showed that GOLDEN ACTION went wrong at the ¼ pole (right front fetlock) and jockey Ochoa jumped clear of the injured horse. The horse was euthanized at the scene. Ochoa had a contusion on his forehead, a sprained ankle, and some bruised ribs.

#1 GAVYN'S GOLD, trained by Jamey Thomas, was scratched on the recommendation of Dr. Kerr, who stated the horse injured itself during the loading process. On Vet's list. The refund amounted to \$19,286.48.

#5 AFTERTHELUVIN, trained by Frances Henderson, was scratched on the advice of Dr. Kerr, as the field was warming up, after she reported the horse was off in the hindquarters. On Vet's list. The refund amounted to \$6,703.00.

06-08-08<sup>4</sup> **LATE SCRATCH – Fourth Race – REFUND**

#8 SUNNY WAGER, trained by Ed Moger, was scratched by the stewards when Dr. Kerr stated the horse reared and struck his head in the paddock. On Vet's list. The refund was \$4,692.58.

06-08-08<sup>5</sup> **STEWARDS' INQUIRY – Sixth Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards illuminated the inquiry sign to review an incident at the wire involving the winner, #1 OMI'S BACK, ridden by Kyle Kaenel, and the show horse #2 CHARMING SURPRISE, with Omar Figueroa in the saddle. After a thorough review the stewards made no change in the order of finish.

Tapes showed that OMI'S BACK stepped in just before the wire causing CHARMING SURPRISE to steady momentarily but the incident did not cost the latter a placing. Kaenel will review the films of the race.

06-08-08<sup>6</sup> **STEWARDS' INQUIRY – Eighth Race – DISQUALIFICATION**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to review an incident at the 1/8 involving the place horse, #8 FIRST TAKE, ridden by Russell Baze, #4 STAR PROTOCOL (6<sup>th</sup>, Roberto Gonzalez) and #1 LOTTA TEXAS CHARM (10<sup>th</sup>, Catalino Martinez). After a thorough review the stewards disqualified FIRST TAKE from second and placed her sixth for interference in the stretch.

Tapes of the race showed that Baze angled FIRST TAKE out from behind horses in search of racing room as he neared the 1/8. On his way out, FIRST TAKE bumped a tiring LOTTA TEXAS CHARM and then continued out, bumping and impeding STAR PROTOCOL. It was the stewards' unanimous opinion that STAR PROTOCOL was cost a placing. FIRST TAKE was disqualified and placed sixth. Although LOTTA TEXAS CHARM was also bothered in the incident the stewards were not convinced that the horse lost the opportunity at a better placing.
