11-26-08<sup>2</sup> **RULING NO. 40 – MANIAR** (Case #08GG153)

Owner **DINESH MANIAR**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Sunday, November 23, 2008, to answer charges of alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility), is hereby suspended pending appearance before the Board of Stewards for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges

of DINESH MANIAR are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The above ruling was issued after Maniar failed to appear to address a complaint filed by former trainer **JOHN MARTIN** alleging \$27,187.00 due for services rendered.

11-26-08<sup>3</sup> **RULING NO. 41 – HOLLENDORFER** (Case #08GG167)

Trainer **JERRY HOLLENDORFER** is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for failure to properly report the gelding of the horse **HARAKA HARAKA** prior to the third race on Friday, November 14, 2008 at Golden Gate Fields, which is a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse).

The above ruling was issued after Hollendorfer appeared, waived his right to a formal hearing and pled guilty. Jerry knew the horse was a gelding and assumed the papers reflected the same. His assumption proved incorrect and the above penalty was imposed.

11-26-08<sup>4</sup> **LATE SCRATCH – First Race – REFUND**

#5 SWEET N SHINEY, trained by R. B. Hess, was scratched by the stewards after the horse froze up in the post parade, unseated jockey Russell Baze, and refused to approach the gate. This was the second and last chance for SWEET N SHINEY who was scratched for the same behavior in October. The refund amounted to \$67,994.64.

11-26-08<sup>5</sup> **STEWARDS’ INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – Fourth Race – NO CHANGE**

#4 GROUPOFTHEFUTURE, trained by Nick Sloan, went wrong (condylar fracture – left front fetlock) at the 6 ½ and unseated jockey Matt Hagerty. The horse was captured at the ¾ and euthanized at the scene. Hagerty was removed from the track in the ambulance and transported to the hospital for leg x-rays. Further examination showed no broken bones.

11-27-08<sup>2</sup> **RULING NO. 42 – GOMEZ**

Jockey **EULICES GOMEZ** is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for failure to ride his mount in the first race on Friday, November 21, 2008; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

The above ruling was issued after Gomez contacted the stewards by phone from southern California and was unable to provide a viable reason for not riding his mount last week.

11-27-08<sup>3</sup> **STEWARDS' INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – Seventh Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to determine the cause of a spill at the 5/16 involving #2 ADEVILGETSHISDUE, trained by Mark Rheinford and ridden by Chris Landeros. After a thorough review the stewards removed the inquiry sign.

Tapes showed that ADEVILGETSHISDUE went wrong (condylar fracture – left front) at the 5/16 and fell throwing Landeros. No other horses were involved although #3 BIG RED TATE steadied around the fallen horse.

ADEVILGETSHISDUE was euthanized at the scene. Landeros was taken by ambulance to the hospital for x-rays but suffered only bruises.

11-29-08<sup>2</sup> **FILM REVIEW**

Jockeys **Chris Landeros** and **Kyle Kaenel** viewed the tapes of yesterday's fifth race and both were cautioned to be more aware not only of their position in a race but also the presence of those around them.

11-29-08<sup>3</sup> **LATE SCRATCH – First Race – REFUND**

#2 PERFECTLY SWEET, trained by Gloria Buckridge, was scratched on the recommendation of Dr. Kerr who reported the filly became fractious in the starting gate and injured herself. On Vet's List. The refund amounted to \$27,714.20.

11-29-08<sup>4</sup> **STEWARDS' INQUIRY – Seventh Race – DISQUALIFICATION**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to evaluate the start and the actions of #8 FEST TIMES GEAR, ridden by Saul Arias. After a thorough review the stewards disqualified FEST TIMES GEAR from fourth and placed him ninth behind #7 PEPITO AT LAST. Tapes showed that FEST TIME GEAR broke in at the start initiating a chain reaction that impeded #7 PEPITO AT LAST, #6 NOBLE ROYAL and #5 DEEP'N IT.

For the five day race week all races written exclusively for horses bred in California failed to fill and were called off.

11-30-08<sup>3</sup> **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey **Saul Arias** appeared to review yesterday's seventh race in which his mount was disqualified for interference at the start. Tapes showed that Saul's horse broke in and Arias reacted quickly, albeit in vain, to correct his mount's errant path. Saul was held blameless.

11-30-08<sup>4</sup> **RULING NO. 43 – MIYADI**

Trainer **STEVE MIYADI** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for failure to have the horse DESPERATE on the grounds at the proper time necessitating a late declaration from the third race on Saturday, November 29, 2008; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1698 (Failure to Start and Run).

The above ruling was issued after Miyadi conversed with the stewards about the incident. Steve reported the wrong horse was shipped from Pleasanton and by the time the mistake was discovered it was too late to get the right horse here.

11-30-08<sup>5</sup> **LATE SCRATCHES – Sixth Race – REFUNDS**

#3 BLACK CINDER, trained by Nick Sloan, was scratched during the warm up on the recommendation of Dr. Kerr who diagnosed the filly was off in the left front. On Vet's list. The refund amounted to \$3,909.00.

#5 STORMS WHISPER, trained by Quinn Howey, was scratched by the stewards after Dr. Kerr reported the filly injured herself after acting up in the starting gate. On Vet's list. The refund totaled \$50,588.70.

11-30-08<sup>6</sup> **TRAINER OBJECTION – Seventh Race – NO CHANGE**

Armando Lage, sub-trainer of the show horse, #4 SKIM SCAM, lodged a claim of foul against the place horse, #2 SCORPIO DOG, alleging interference at the 7/8. After a thorough review the stewards dismissed the objection. Tapes showed nothing occurred between the two horses at any point in the race.
