03-11-10³ **MANUEL R. CALVARIO** (09GG0388)

A formal hearing was held for owner / trainer **MANUEL R. CALVARIO**, who has been charged with alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility). Mr. Calvario was represented by attorney **Brian Pitnick**.

In addition to the Board of Stewards, those present included groom **FERNANDO N. CANDELARIA**, the complainant, CHRB Supervising Investigator Anne Glasscock, CHRB Senior Investigator Carol Nolan and C.S.R. Christine Niccoli, who recorded the proceedings.

Mr. Candelaria's complaint alleged non payment of wages totaling \$1,795.00 owed to

him by Mr. Calvario. The term of employment was August 18, 2009 through September 22, 2009.

After oral and documentary evidence was submitted, the record was closed.

03-12-10¹ **CAL-BRED REPORT**

With the above declaration the field of horses was reduced to four wagering interests and in compliance with CHRB rule 1954 (Pari-Mutuel Pools) no show wagering was offered. The additional refund amounted to \$75.00.

03-12-10³ **STEVE MIYADI** (09GG393)

A formal hearing was held for owner/trainer **STEVEN MIYADI** to address a California Horse Racing Board complaint alleging violation of rules #1843, #1866, #1887 and #1930. Mr. Miyadi was not represented by counsel.

CHRB Senior Investigator Charles Smith presented the case and C.S.R. Christine Niccoli recorded the proceedings.

Mr. Miyadi pleaded no contest to the charge that his horse LELA FOR MARY, showed Phenylbutazone (5.83 ug/ml) in excess of the permitted level, following a workout on December 19, 2009. LELA FOR MARY was working for removal from the Veterinarian's List.

03-12-10⁴ **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – First Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the first race for a review of an incident in the stretch involving #1 MICHAEL THE MAN (Leslie Mawing), second and #3 FLASHY GREEN (Frank Alvarado), fourth.

After interviewing the riders, considering the patrol judges report and reviewing the tape of the race, the stewards decided unanimously to disqualify #1 MICHAEL THE MAN from second to fourth for drifting in and impeding #3 FLASHY GREEN inside the 1/16th pole, preventing the latter the opportunity of a better placing.

03-13-10³ **RULING NO. 47 – CALVARIO** (09GG0388)

Owner / Trainer **MANUEL R. CALVARIO** having now appeared for a hearing is restored to good standing and Pacific Racing Association Ruling #30, dated February 11, 2010, suspending Mr. Calvario for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) is hereby set aside.

Further, Manuel R. Calvario is suspended thirty (30) days, retroactively from February 11 through March 12, 2010, with credit given for time served for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility – failure to pay wages when due).

The foregoing ruling was issued following the formal hearing held on Friday, March 11, 2010.

Mr. Calvario has resolved the unpaid wage dispute, but was clearly in violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876.

03-13-10⁴ **RULING NO. 48 – MAWING** (Refer: 03-12-10⁴)

Jockey **LESLIE MAWING**, who rode **MICHAEL THE MAN** in the first race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, March 12, 2010, is suspended five (5) racing days (March 20, 21, 25, 26 and 27, 2010) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from second to fourth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Mawing and the stewards reviewed the film of the first race from March 12, 2010.

Mr. Mawing does not dispute that interference occurred, but contends his mount was unmanageable and he should not be held accountable.

The stewards unanimously disagreed as there was no visible evidence that the rider made any effort to keep his mount on a straight course.

This is Mr. Mawing’s second riding infraction recently (suspended three days on 3-6-10) and therefore a five day suspension is warranted.

03-13-10⁵ **RULING NO. 49 – MIYADI** (09GG393)

Trainer **STEVE MIYADI**, who worked the horse LELA FOR MARY for removal from the veterinarian’s list at Golden Gate Fields on December 19, 2009, is fined the sum of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1866 (Veterinarian’s List) and #1843 (a) & (d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances: Phenylbutazone – in excess of permitted level [5.83 ug/ml] – Class 4 – second offense).

The above ruling was issued following the formal hearing held on March 12, 2010.

This excess Phenylbutazone violation was Mr. Miyadi’s second within a year and third in thirteen months.

03-13-10⁶ **INQUIRY – ACCIDENT – Third Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the third race to review an incident near the 3/8 pole.

The tapes show #1 GIANT STEPS jumped the shadow of a light standard and unseated jockey **Leslie Mawing**. Neither horse nor rider were injured.
