Report for the period Wednesday, April 14, 2010 through Sunday, April 18, 2010.**Wednesday**04-14-10 **DUTY STEWARD**

Steward John Herbuveaux was on duty this non-racing day to handle entries and declarations and will continue throughout this reporting period.

Thursday04-15-10¹ **CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$9,500. For California bred or California sired maiden fillies, three years old, claiming price \$12,500 at six furlongs. The race failed to fill Cal-Bred and was used open with ten wagering interests scheduled to start.

04-15-10² **RULING NO. 61 – KOLOMIZA**

Owner **DMITRIY KOLOMIZA**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Sunday, April 11, 2010, to answer charges of alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility), is hereby suspended pending appearance before the Board of Stewards for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of **DMITRIY KOLOMIZA** are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The preceding ruling was issued after Dmitriy Kolomiza failed to appear to address an alleged debt of \$394.00 owed to **San Francisco Equine**.

04-15-10³ **RULING NO. 62 – HENDERSON**

Trainer **FRANCES HENDERSON** is fined the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1894 (Duties of Trainer) for failure to deliver the horse **FREE LOVIN'** to the receiving barn, necessitating a late scratch in the seventh race on Saturday, April 10, 2010; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1852 (Reporting to Receiving Barn).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Ms. Henderson met with the stewards and failed to offer a valid explanation for failing to bring her horse to the receiving barn for the seventh race on Saturday, April 10, 2010. Ms. Henderson stated her groom failed to hear the call from the receiving barn for the seventh race.

04-15-10⁴ **OTIS D. BAILEY FINANCIAL**

CHRB complaint 10GG0079, filed against owner **OTIS D. BAILEY** by trainer **Art Riesgo** for a training debt of \$7,013.75, was resolved between parties for a reduced amount of \$2,011.00. Notice that the debt has been resolved is attached to the original complaint.

04-16-10³ **RULING NO. 63 – BUGRIYEV**

Owner **ALEX BUGRIYEV**, having failed to respond to written notice to appear before the Board of Stewards at Golden Gate Fields on or before Thursday, April 15, 2010, to answer charges of alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility), is hereby suspended pending appearance before the Board of Stewards

for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of ALEX BUGRIYEV are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards), subject is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Bugriyev failed to appear to address CHRB complaint 10GG057 filed by San Francisco Equine for an alleged debt of \$1,541.00 owed for veterinary services. Had Mr. Bugriyev appeared for the hearing, San Francisco Equine was going to argue Mr. Bugriyev was liable for the full amount which includes \$770.63 that was owed by a 50% partner who filed Chapter 7 Bankruptcy which may or may not have been included in the bankruptcy.

04-16-10⁴ **MARK M. WALKER HEARING**

A hearing was held for trainer Mark M. Walker to address CHRB complaint 10GG013. Mr. Walker was cited after the blood sample of his horse, NAT THE BRAT that race in the fifth race on January 15, 2010, tested with more than one approved non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug substance (Phenylbutazone – 1.79 ug/ml; Flunixin – 28 ng/ml). Mr. Walker signed a Waiver of Hearing and requested to address the matter without a court reporter.

Mr. Walker acknowledged administering Phenylbutazone to the horse but was at a loss as to how the Flunixin got in the horses system, however, he has his suspicions. Decision to follow.

04-18-10¹ **CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$10,000. For California bred or California Sired fillies and mares, four years old and upward, claiming price \$8,000 at six furlongs. Only five horses were entered in the race and the race was called off.

04-18-10³ **RULING NO. 64 – WALKER** (Refer: 04-16-10⁴)

Trainer **MARK M. WALKER**, who started the horse **NAT THE BRAT**, seventh place finisher in the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields on January 15, 2010, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances: more than one approved – Phenylbutazone and Flunixin).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Walker met with the stewards on the above referenced date and pled guilty.

04-18-10⁴ **INQUIRY -ACCIDENT – NO CHANGE - First Race**

The inquiry sign was posted following the running of the first race for a review of an accident near the 5/8 pole on the turf involving #1 DIANNE DO, ridden by jockey Alex Gonzalez. The recording shows #1 veer to the left and go through the inside rail. Jockey Gonzalez jumped off prior to the horse going through the rail and appeared to escape serious injury. The horse galloped around the infield and jumped in the lake for a swim prior to allowing someone to finally catch her.

After examination it was reported by track physician Dr. David Seftel that Mr. Gonzalez sustained a sprained left knee and a concussion after which replacement riders were found for his remaining mounts. The horse sustained a cut on the shin which required minor medical attention. No other horses were involved or affected by the accident.

04-18-10⁵ **OBJECTION – NO CHANGE – Second Race**

Following the running of the second race, jockey Leslie Mawing, rider of third place finisher #2 JUSTOURIMAGINATION, lodged an objection against the winner, #5 RICHLY RED (jockey Juan Hernandez) for alleged interference approaching the sixteenth pole.

After talking with the riders involved and reviewing the recordings of the incident no change was made to the order of finish.

The digital recordings show a minor drift outward by #5 which caused #2 to shift out. The incident was minor and clearly did not rise to the level of affecting a placing.
