12-04-10<sup>3</sup> **TRACK MEETING**

The stewards convened a meeting this morning to address recent injuries to horses on the Tapeta main track.

Present, in addition to the stewards, were General Manager Robert Hartman, C.T.T. Representative Charles Dougherty and Safety Steward Paul Nicolo.

At issue are concerns about the condition of the Tapeta surface and whether the recent injuries are an anomaly or a lack of maintenance to the track.

All agreed that neglect of, or improper maintenance was not the problem, but rather the sudden change in weather. The extreme cold weather front that passed through the area, preceded by and then followed by heavy rains, appears to have had an adverse effect on the synthetic surface.

Mr. Hartman indicated that they are considering an application of fibers and a polymer component when weather permits, that may help to rectify the situation.
