**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Rafael Bejarano met with the Stewards to review the fourth race yesterday. Mr. Bejarano allowed his horse to drift outward nearing the wire. The concern is that Mr. Bejarano, in the past, has had tendencies to allow his mounts to drift down the lane. This incident did not warrant a penalty but he left the office with a warning that an accumulation of this practice will warrant a penalty.

Jockey Joe Steiner reported to the Stewards' office to discuss his ride in the fifth race yesterday. Mr. Steiner created some tight quarters going into the first turn and he stated that this mount had shied away from the horse to his outside and forefront. Mr. Steiner was not held culpable for this incident.

Jockey Martin Pedroza was also directed to come to the Stewards' office to watch the ninth race yesterday. Mr. Pedroza allowed his mount to drift outward nearing the wire creating a bump with an outside rival as they reached the finish. He was told that although this did not warrant a penalty we expect safe riding to add to the preservation of the horse population. He stated that he understood.

**HRTH #049**

Exercise rider **APRIL DOORBOS** is fined **ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)\*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct), with such fine to be stayed provided that subject remain on probation for the term of her license (April 30, 2013) and not violate California Horse Racing Board rule #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) during that period.

This ruling was issued after Ms. Doornbos was made aware of the Steward's decision.

**INQUIRY FOURTH RACE (1 1/16 miles-turf)- NO CHANGE**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident into the first turn. Involved were #3 Nahem (6<sup>th</sup> V. Espinoza), #5 Smug (5<sup>th</sup> C. Sutherland) and #7 Boxeur Des Rues (1<sup>st</sup> J. Rosario). After conversation with the Patrol Judge and all jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision to let the original order of finish stand. The #3 did have to take up sharply mid turn, #5 was to his outside and #7 was on the outside of the three horse spread. #5 and #7 held their line while #3 was rank and had to be held back due to lack of room causing his own difficulty.

**INQUIRY AND DISQUALIFICATION EIGHTH RACE (6 furlongs-cushion)**

Following the running of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident near mid-stretch. Involved were #1 Amazombie (1<sup>st</sup> M. Smith), #3 M One Rifle (3<sup>rd</sup> C. Sutherland) and #4 Camp Victory (2<sup>nd</sup> J. Talamo). After a long review and conversation with the Patrol Judge and all jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision to disqualify # 1 from first to third behind # 3. It was the Stewards' opinion that as the three horse spread straightened away for the finish, there was an opening between #7 Cost of Freedom and #3. When the jockey of #1 sent his mount for this spot the opening closed before he could gain a position between the two horses. This shift caused #1 and #4 to bump sending #3 into #4. This chain reaction cost #3 and #4 the opportunity of a better placing.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Mike Smith met with the Stewards to review the disqualification in the eighth race Monday. Jockey Guild Representative Darrell Haire was available to represent Mr. Smith. Also in attendance was Laffit Pincay Jr. to help defend Mr. Smith. The BOS were unanimous in the decision that the events which caused the disqualification, and were unavoidable once he made the decision to split horses. Mr. Smith was not held culpable for the resulting interference.

Jockey Chantal Sutherland met with the Stewards to review the eighth and ninth races. It was agreed that her actions in both races were not worthy of a penalty, but she admitted that she needs to make better efforts guiding her mounts.

Mr. Procel withdrew the complaint after he was advised to file against the owner not the trainer.

**AVENATTI FORMAL HEARING CASE #10SA136**

This complaint filed by the California Horse Racing Board against Owner Jay Michael Avenatti for a possible violation of rule 1489(a) (c) (Grounds of Denial or Refusal of License). Court Reporter Barbara Weinstein was available to record the proceedings. Investigator Rick Amieva presented the case for the CHRB, Mr. Avenatti was present along with his counsel Suzanne Porrazzo and Vic Stauffer was present as an observer. After it was verified that the previous charges against Mr. Avenatti were ordered expunged by the Superior Court of San Bernardino County and his probation had been terminated Mr. Avenatti then became eligible to be licensed in California. Subsection (a) of CHRB rule 1489 was dismissed from the complaint but the following ruling was issued due to the violation of subsection (c) of CHRB rule #1489.

Owner **JAY MICHAEL AVENATTI**, having appeared as ordered, is restored to good standing. Ruling #LATS 027, issued at Los Angeles Turf Club on January 14, 2011, is set aside. Additionally, Jay Michael Avenatti is fine **TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00)\*** pursuant to California

Horse Racing Board rule #1489(c) (Material Misrepresentation on License Application).

**INQUIRY SIXTH RACE (1 1/16 miles-cushion)**

After the finish of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review an incident inside the 5/16 pole, involved were #3 Hot Ticket (2<sup>nd</sup> R. Bejarano), #7 Mystery Bird (8<sup>th</sup> P. Valenzuela) and #8 Sexy Melody (9<sup>th</sup> T. Baze). After a review of the videos, conversation with the Patrol Judge and all jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision to let the original order of finish stand. It was the Stewards opinion that #7 stepped into #3 and the contact then sent him outward into the path of #8 causing that one to clip heels and stumble. There was not a change in the order of finish due to the fact that #7 and #8 finished last and next to last and #3 was blameless.

**INQUIRY SEVENTH RACE (1 1/16 miles-turf)**

After the finish of the race the inquiry sign was posted to review the start of the race. Involved was #1 Calimonco (5<sup>th</sup> J. Rosario). As the gates opened the horse turned his head to the right and got his nose stuck behind the upright. Video verified that the assistant starter released the horse. After conversation with jockey Joel Rosario, who also verified the actions of the horse #1 Calimonco was declared a starter and the race was made official.

**EIGHTH RACE DELAY**

Following the running of the race the BOS received information that galloping back to the winners circle jockey Edwin Maldonado aboard # 7 Johnnie Gold may have dropped something in his left boot. The BOS notified Ruben Hernandez (Clerk of Scales) to follow Mr. Maldonado along with two Security Guards to the jockey quarters to verify or discount the report. Charles McCaul (Assistant Clerk of Scales) was also notified that this procedure was occurring and was told to have a jockey guild representative available (Joel Rosario) to oversee the process. After a report that Mr. Maldonado had nothing in his boot the BOS declared the race official.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Patrick Valenzuela joined the Stewards to review the sixth race in which he was involved in some bumping on the far turn. It was agreed that the contact started when Mr. Valenzuela stepped inward, the Stewards felt the horse was culpable for this shift, not Mr. Valenzuela. (Reference 06-03-11<sup>2</sup>)

Jockey Edwin Maldonado met with the stewards to discuss the first race last night. Although Mr. Maldonado allowed his mount to drift in the stretch, this did not create an infraction but he was warned to make corrections sooner to prevent penalties in the future. He agreed with our assessment and stated he would make better efforts. The BOS also discussed with Mr. Maldonado the procedure that took place following the last race last night. He stated that after he turned the horse around to gallop back to the winner's circle that he reached down and pulled his leggings up and this could be what initiated the report that the BOS had received after the race. **MILLER HEARING CASE #11HP018**

The complaint filed by the CHRB alleging that trainer Peter Miller violated CHRB rule 1865 (Altering of Sex of Horse). Mitigating circumstances were discussed and Mr. Miller was afforded the opportunity and time to produce added documents that might help his defense. More to follow.
