FILM REVIEW

Jockey MARTIN PEDROZA was in the office this morning to review the sixth race on Saturday. Mr. Pedroza's mount appeared to interfere with #7 Platinum Mine, causing that horse to steady for a stride when his mount shifted in slightly at the five-sixteenths pole. We issued a warning, feeling that it did not rise to level of suspension.

Jockey CHANTAL SUTHERLAND came to the office as directed this morning to review her ride in the sixth race yesterday in which her mount shifted out a bit at the five sixteenths pole. We felt that she could have been a little more patient before she made her move. She agreed.

Jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA was also in to review films for the first race on Saturday in which his mount shifted out slightly. He partially blamed the horse to his outside but also took some responsibility and left the office with the admonition to be more careful in the future.

RANGEL HEARING AND RULING

A formal hearing was held in our office this morning (case number 11HP022) alleging violation of CHRB rules 1489 and 1902. Mr. Rangel failed to appear, so we therefore issued the following ruling:

HRT# #055

Groom **JORGE RANGEL**, having failed to appear as ordered to answer charges alleging a violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1489(h)(Engaged in the Use of Drugs) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing), is suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1547 (Failure to Appear).

During the term of suspension, all licenses and license privileges of Jorge Rangel are suspended and pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1528 (Jurisdiction of Stewards to Suspend or Fine), Mr. Rangel is denied access to all premises in this jurisdiction.

The incident involved #7 Adina angling out into the path of #4 Talktoomuch, who was forced to steady. After speaking with the patrol judges and riders involved, we unanimously voted to make no change to the original of finish because in our opinion, #4 Talktoomuch, was not cost the opportunity at a better placing.

Mr. O'Neill contacted the office before the hearing and indicated that he would not attend the hearing but would accept any ruling. The hearing was held and a ruling will follow.

Upon review of the DRF, it appeared as if that claim may have validity. We contacted the Racing Office and CHRB investigators for further inquiry. We also put a hold on the winners' portion of the purse. More to follow.
