**DISQUALIFICATION RULING**

**HRTH #001**

Acting on a report from the University of California, Maddy Analytical Laboratory, the official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #F08732, obtained from the horse "MR RIVER OF DREAMS", the sixth place finisher in the fourth race at the Los Angeles County Fair on September 25, 2011 contained the drug substance Clenbuterol (Class 3) in excess of the permitted level, it is ordered that "MR RIVER OF DREAMS" be disqualified and deemed unplaced pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Finding). All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling.
