Report of the Board of Stewards for the week of October 18, 2011 through October 23, 2011.

**TUESDAY**

10/18/2011

(1) DUTY STEWARD

George Slender will be present for morning duties and will record the minutes during this reporting period.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The fourth race in the book for Friday, maiden two year olds, was called off with three CAL-BREDS. The seventh race in the book for three year olds and upward, claiming price \$6,250.00 was off with one entry.

(3) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Friday's program. Four Thoroughbreds and six Quarter Horse races completed the card.

**WEDNESDAY**

10/19/2011

(1) SCRATCHES

Friday's scratches were conducted promptly at 9:00 a.m. without noteworthy incident.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

The second race in the book failed to fill with three CAL-BREDS. Sub six was called off with two entries.

(3) THE DRAW

Ten races were used for Saturday's program, which consisted of two Thoroughbred and eight Quarter Horse races. The draw was completed at 2:00 p.m.

**THURSDAY**

10/20/2011

(1) SCRATCHES

Saturday's scratches were conducted promptly at 9:00 a.m.

(2) CAL-BRED REPORT

Two CAL-BRED races were offered for Sunday's racing program. Both failed to fill.

(3) THE DRAW

Ten races were drawn for Sunday's program. Three Thoroughbred and seven Quarter Horse races completed the card.

**FRIDAY**

10/21/2011

(1) EARLY PROGRAM SCRATCHES

1<sup>st</sup> Race - # 1 Special Lenee (Tr. A. Soto) injured, Dr. Hackathorn.

4<sup>th</sup> Race - # 5 Hawkinsons (Tr. E. Sirin) sick, Dr. Hackathorn.

(2) DE LA TORRE CASE CON'T

The purse disqualification of case #11LA0248 and case #11LA0200 was continued until November 4, 2011 at the request of attorney Richard Moore for getting various documents on record.

(3) JOCKEY TO FILMS

Jockey Antonio Alberto appeared before the Stewards as requested. The Stewards counseled subject to give a more concerted effort in controlling his mount.

(4) SECOND RACE – INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION

The Stewards immediately posted the Inquiry sign following the running of the second race (Quarter Horse – 300 yards) to review an incident at the start. Involved were #5 "Tellin Lies" (jockey C. De Alba – 5<sup>th</sup>), #4 "Boxcars Again" (jockey A. Alberto – 2<sup>nd</sup>) and #3 "Johnydwundahorse" (A. Luna – 6<sup>th</sup>).

After speaking with the riders involved and reviewing the tape replays, the Stewards unanimously agreed to disqualify #5 from fifth to sixth position. Replays show #5 veering in at the start bumping #4 pushing the latter down into #3, costing both horses an opportunity of better placement.

(5) SEVENTH RACE – JOCKEY OBJECTION – NO CHANGE

Following the running of the seventh race the jockey on #4 "Something Sonic" (4<sup>th</sup> – jockey Jesse Chavis) lodged a claim of foul against #5 (2<sup>nd</sup> – jockey Ramon Guce) for alleged interference down the backside. After a review of the film and talking with the jockeys involved it was a unanimous decision to let the original order of finish stand due to the fact that the films did not verify the claim of foul.

(1) FARIAS RULINGRULING #221

ACTING UPON A REPORT FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA DAVIS, AN OFFICIAL TESTING LABORATORY OF THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD THAT BLOOD AND URINE SAMPLE# LA17946, TAKEN FROM THE HORSE "IN A SEPARATE CLASS", THE FIRST PLACE FINISHER IN THE FOURTH RACE AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE ON MAY 15, 2011, TESTED POSITIVE FOR CLENBUTEROL (CLASS III). IT IS ORDERED THAT "IN A SEPARATE CLASS" BE DISQUALIFIED FROM ALL PURSE MONIES EARNED IN SAID RACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1859.5 (DISQUALIFICATION UPON POSITIVE TEST).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT ALL PURSE MONIES (\$5,335) EARNED BY OWNER ISLA VISTA RANCH SS, INC., TRAINER ADAN FARIAS AND JOCKEY ALEX BAUTISTA BE RETURNED TO THE PAYMASTER OF PURSES AT LOS ALAMITOS RACE COURSE BY NOVEMBER 21, 2011 FOR REDISTRIBUTION PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1760 (PURSE AWARD OR PRIZE TO BE WITH HELD)

REVISED ORDER OF FINISH IS AS FOLLOWS:

ALL RECORDS ARE ORDERED TO REFLECT THIS RULING IN ACCORDANCE WITH CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #1956 (RACE DECLARED OFFICIAL), THIS RULING SHALL NOT AFFECT THE PARI-MUTUEL PAYOFFS.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Farias was given an informal hearing and accepted accountability pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

(2) BAZE HEARING (CASE #11DM0070)

A formal hearing was conducted for jockey Tyler Baze to address the above referenced complaint alleging violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1485 (License Subject to Conditions and Agreements), #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) and #1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing).

Present at the hearing were jockey Tyler Baze, his agent Craig O'Brien, Guild Manager Darrell Haire, Winners Foundation Director Robert Fletcher, Steward Scott Cheney, Investigators Bill Westermann and Rick Amieva who presented the case, Safety Steward Randy Winick and the three Board of Stewards Albert Christiansen, James Dreyer and George Slender. The proceedings were recorded by Barbara Weinstein.

Mr. Baze admitted to the violations in the complaint but disagreed that he was intoxicated while exercising horses. Subject has inquired into rehabilitation programs, attended some meetings but yet has failed to commit in a program. Decision to be rendered soon.
