Acting upon a report from Truesdail Laboratories, an official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #K30688, obtained from the horse "Mojave Moon", the third place finisher in the fourth race on June 11, 2000, at Hollywood Park, contained the prohibited drug Morphine, a class one substance, it is therefore ordered that "Mojave Moon" be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race, in accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that the owner of "Mojave Moon", Donald Harrison (Flaxman Holdings LTD), jockey Brice Blanc return purse monies to the paymaster of purses at Hollywood Park for redistribution in accordance with California Horse Racing Rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

4th – Dancing Afleet

All records shall be changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board, Rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) The pari-mutuel payoffs for this race are not affected.
