RULING NO. 22

In accordance with a stipulated agreement and acting on a report from the University of California at Davis Maddy Laboratories, that the pre-race blood sample #TC69269L, taken from the horse AT A BOY LUTHER, third place finisher in the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields on August 27, 2006, contained a carbon dioxide level of 39.5 millimoles per liter, an amount in excess of the permitted level, a class III violation, it is hereby ordered that AT A BOY LUTHER be disqualified from all purse monies earned and deemed unplaced, in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that all purse monies (\$1,350.00) earned or awarded to owner Trans Atlantic Racing Stable be returned to the Paymaster of Purses for redistribution pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

The revised order of finish is as follows:

- 3rd - TEXAS CHILI
- 4th - CAPTAIN SKYHAWK
- 5th - FUMAN SLEW
- 6th - MANGUSTA

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official) this ruling shall not affect the pari-mutuel payoffs.
