Based upon a report from Truesdail Laboratories, an official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample K30669, obtained from the horse STARMANIAC, the first place finisher in the sixth race at Hollywood Park on June 10, 2000, contained the prohibited drug morphine (Class I), it is ordered that STARMANIAC be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race, in accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that the purse money earned in said race (\$24,000.00) that has been returned by owner Amerman Racing Stables be redistributed in accordance with the revised order of finish.

Revised Order of Finish

- 1st – Clure
- 2nd – Teddy Boy
- 3rd – Miramar (FR)
- 4th – Champagne Prince (GB)
- 5th – Goldfame (IR)

All records are ordered changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1956 (Race Declared Official), neither the pari-mutuel payout nor the distribution of any pari-mutuel pool shall be affected.
