Acting upon a report from the University of California, Davis Laboratories, an official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that urine sample #R45041, obtained from the horse DANCING GROOM, the second place finisher in the fourth race on July 22, 2005, at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club, contained the prohibited drug Clenbuterol, a class three substance, it is therefore ordered that DANCING GROOM be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race, in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that the owner of DANCING GROOM, MATTHEW RASICH (Tule Creek Farm), jockey VICTOR ESPINOZA, and trainer SANTIAGO MEDINA return purse monies to the Paymaster of Purses at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club for redistribution in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse Award or Prize to be Withheld).

All records shall be changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board Rule #1956 (Race Declared Official), the pari-mutuel payoffs for this race are not affected.
