

Corrected ruling #084 – re date of race

Acting upon a report from the University of California, Davis Laboratories, an official testing laboratory for the California Horse Racing Board, that blood sample TC 75994, obtained from the horse DYNOUT, the second place finisher in the sixth race on November 19, 2006, at Hollywood Park, contained a Total Carbon Dioxide (TCO₂) amount in excess of the permitted level (37.6 millimoles per liter of TCO₂) which constitutes a Class 3 substance; it is therefore ordered that DYNOUT be disqualified from all purse monies earned in said race, in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1859.5 (Disqualification Upon Positive Test Finding).

It is further ordered that the owner of DYNOUT, DANIEL CAPEN, return \$9,200.00, the jockey of DYNOUT, MICHAEL BAZE, return \$460.00 and the trainer of DYNOUT, MICHAEL MITCHELL return \$920.00 to the Paymaster of Purses at Hollywood Park for redistribution in accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1760 (Purse to be Withheld) by April 14, 2007.

- 3rd – (DH) SLEEPLESS JOY
- 3rd – (DH) STYLIN CAT
- 5th – SPUNKY HARRY

All records shall be changed to reflect this ruling. In accordance with California Horse Racing Board rule #1956 (Race Declared Official), neither the pari-mutuel payout nor the distribution of any pari-mutuel pool shall be affected.
