Trainer **ERIC GUILLOT**, who started the horse “Champagne D’Oro” in the sixth race at Del Mar Thoroughbred Club on August 9, 2009, having entered into a stipulated agreement with the California Horse Racing Board, is fined **THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00)*** and suspended for **THIRTY (30) DAYS (October 23, 2009 thru November 21, 2009)** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1843 (a)(d)(Medication, Drugs and Other Substances), #1843.1(a)(Prohibited Drug Substances-Trenbolone) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse).

Pursuant of the terms of the stipulated settlement, twenty five (25) days of the suspension (October 28, 2009 thru November 21, 2009) are stayed provided that Respondent be placed on probation for a period of one year (October 20, 2010). During the period of probation Respondent Eric Guillot must not be in violation of California Horse Racing Board Rules and Regulations, sections 1843, 1843.6 and 1887 regarding Class I, II, or III drug substances.
