TRAINER **LOU PENA**, WHO STARTED “**YANKEE VELOCITY**” IN THE TWELFTH RACE ON FEBRUARY 27, 2004, AT CAPITOL RACING, CAL-EXPO IS HEREBY FINED THE SUM OF ONE THOUSAND (**\$1,000.00**)\* DOLLARS PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #**1887** (TRAINER TO INSURE CONDITION OF HORSE) FOR VIOLATION OF CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD RULE #**1843 (D)** (MEDICATIONS, DRUGS, AND OTHER SUBSTANCES – ‘**METHYLPREDNISOLONE**’ [CLASS 6]) (MULTIPLE VIOLATIONS IN 12 MONTH PERIOD)

\*California Horse Racing Board rule # 1532 states that all fines shall be paid to the paymaster of purses within seven (7) days of imposition (04-14-04) or the license of the person upon whom the fine was imposed shall be suspended.
