**Postmortem Examination Review Summary #2025L11**

Horse Information: Two-year-old Thoroughbred.

Incident Summary: During a morning gallop the horse sustained a right front leg injury. The horse was ambulated to the hospital and radiographs were performed. The right humerus was found to be fractured and the horse was humanely euthanized.

Necropsy Summary: A necropsy examination revealed a complete displaced, comminuted right humeral fracture. The humerus had sub-periosteal woven bone, which the fracture line intersected. The right front third metacarpus (MC3) had a sub-periosteal callus on the dorsal surface.

Racing/Training History: The horse had shipped into the racetrack approximately one month prior to the injury to begin training.

Veterinary History Summary: The horse was examined and found to be sound prior to the commencement of training.

Pre-race Examinations: N/A.

Conclusion: The horse suffered a catastrophic right shoulder fracture and was humanely euthanized.
