**Postmortem Examination Review Summary #2025E11**

Horse Information: Nine-year-old Standardbred.

Incident Summary: The horse collapsed while being walked by the trainer. The veterinarian was called and provided treatment, but the horse expired.

Necropsy Summary: The necropsy exam suspected cardiorespiratory failure resulting in sudden death. There was no obvious cause of death after gross, histological, and toxicology examination.

Racing/Training History: The horse had 199 total lifetime starts.

Veterinary History Summary: The horse had history of tying up and received water and electrolytes via nasogastric tubing.

Pre-race Examinations: Pre-race examinations noted nothing remarkable.

Conclusion: With no definitive cause of death revealed on necropsy this horse was classified as a sudden death with suspected cardiorespiratory failure.
