**Postmortem Examination Review Summary #2025E05**

Horse Information: Two-year-old Quarter Horse.

Incident Summary: The horse was treated three times for colic over a two-day period. On the third colic episode the horse was transported to the equine hospital. While hospitalized the horse demonstrated persistent and increasing signs of discomfort. The horse was humanely euthanized at the hospital.

Necropsy Summary: A necropsy examination revealed a 360-degree clockwise torsion of the large colon.

Racing/Training History: The horse had seven lifetime starts, and won twice.

Veterinary History Summary: This horse had a history of intra articular injections in 2024.

Pre-race Examinations: Pre-race examinations had noted bilateral carpal effusion, and the right front shin with mild sensitivity to palpation.

Conclusion: This horse was humanely euthanized due to colic.
