**Postmortem Examination Review Summary #2025H06**

Horse Information: Four-year-old Thoroughbred.

Incident Summary: While walking out of the barn the horse fell and landed on the left side. Upon rising the horse had a severe left hind leg lameness. The horse was being treated by a veterinarian, and was placed on stall rest. Several days later the horse was found down in the stall and unable to rise. Veterinarian examination revealed a grave prognosis, and the horse was humanely euthanized.

Necropsy Summary: A necropsy examination revealed completely displaced fractures of the left ilium, pubis, and ischium bones. There was complete dislocation of the pubic symphysis.

Racing/Training History: The horse had 7 lifetime starts. There were gaps in working in late 2022, and again in early 2024.

Veterinary History Summary: The horse was given some time off as a 2-year-old for front shin concerns. The horse had left knee surgery in 2024. In 2023 the horse had exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhage, and was treated.

Pre-race Examinations: Pre-race examinations had noted exostosis and a decreased range of motion in both front fetlock joints. The left knee was noted to have joint effusion.

Conclusion: This horse fractured the pelvis in an accidental fall and was humanely euthanized.
