**Postmortem Examination Review Summary #2025L06**

Horse Information: Two-year-old Thoroughbred.

Incident Summary: During a morning gallop the horse suffered a left front leg injury. The horse was ambulated to the equine hospital and radiographs were performed. The horse was diagnosed with a left humeral fracture and was humanely euthanized.

Necropsy Summary: A necropsy examination revealed a catastrophic left humeral fracture that coursed through a callus.

Racing/Training History: The horse had one recorded work in the summer of 2024 and then had a layoff until winter 2024. The horse had been back in training for approximately 45 days when the injury occurred.

Veterinary History Summary: The horse had a tendon injury in the summer of 2024 and was given time off. The horse had received routine wellness care since returning to the racetrack.

Pre-race Examinations: The horse was unraced.

Conclusion: The horse suffered a catastrophic fracture of the left humerus with evidence of a callus shortly after returning from a layoff.
