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**Postmortem Examination Review Summary #2025G06**

Horse Information: Two-year-old Thoroughbred.

Incident Summary: The right hind leg was swollen, and the horse was placed on antibiotics. On the 4<sup>th</sup> day of treatment, the horse acutely showed signs of illness and expired in the stall.

Necropsy Summary: A necropsy examination concluded the cause of death could not be determined. Several internal organs had hemorrhages suggestive of septicemia. Histology and toxicology both yielded all negative results.

Racing/Training History: The horse was unraced.

Veterinary History Summary: In June 2024, and November 2024, the horse was treated with antibiotics for a swollen hind leg.

Pre-race Examinations: N/A.

Conclusion: The cause of death was not definitively determined in this case.
