**Postmortem Examination Review Summary #2026F05**

Horse Information: Two-year-old Standardbred.

Incident Summary: The horse was found expired in the stall at the dinner feed. The horse had appeared normal all day.

Necropsy Summary: A necropsy examination revealed a left scrotal herniation with small intestine entrapment and compromise but was not strangulated. The horse had a hydro abdomen, a cranial displacement of the pelvic flexure of the large colon, and the right testes had a chronic abscess with a draining tract.

Racing/Training History: The horse had not raced. The horse was walking only for a stifle injury.

Veterinary History Summary: The horse had the stifles radiographed in February 2025 and confirmed a previous injury. In March 2025 the horse was diagnosed and treated for orchitis.

Pre-race Examinations: N/A.

Conclusion: The horse was found expired in the stall with a left scrotal herniation and intestine entrapment, and hydro abdomen.
