**Postmortem Examination Review Summary #2026G01**

Horse Information: Six-year-old Thoroughbred.

Incident Summary: The horse was treated in the evening for colic and appeared normal after treatment. The following morning the horse was found down in the stall and unable to rise. Despite veterinary treatment the horse continued to deteriorate. The horse was humanely euthanized.

Necropsy Summary: A necropsy examination did not determine the cause for the clinical signs of colic.

Racing/Training History: The horse had 51 lifetime starts.

Veterinary History Summary: The horse had intra articular injections done in May 2025 and was placed on the CHRB Vet List in July 2025. The front fetlocks were radiographed in August 2025.

Pre-race Examinations: Pre-race examinations had noted mild joint capsule hypertrophy, a decreased range of motion, and joint effusion in both front fetlock joints. Both shins had mild exostosis.

Conclusion: The horse suffered a severe case of colic that was refractory to veterinary treatment. The horse was humanely euthanized.
