HERRERA HEARING (CASE #26SA0113)

Stable Worker/Groom LUIS HERRERA came in our office to answer to a complaint filed by the CHRB for rule violation #1874 (Disorderly Conduct) for trying to startle a horse away with a pitchfork when cleaning the stable on April 29, 2026. Presenting the case was CHRB Investigator Octavio Vergara, Jr. Investigator Vergara presented us a video, and it failed to show any clear evidence of him harming the horse. In the video, it shows Mr. Herrera shushing the horse back as he entered the stall. Mr. Herrera showed us a bite mark on his left arm from this horse, and he stated this horse had bitten him previously several times. He was very apologetic and stated he would never hurt the horse. After a lengthy discussion, we felt the incident didn't warrant a penalty and the case was dismissed. For the record, the trainer did release Mr. Herrera of his duties. We warned him to be very careful in the future to never use equipment to shush any horse away. He agreed.

STEWARDS' INQUIRY/OBJECTION/DISQUALIFICATION (7th Race)

We posted the inquiry sign after the running of the first race to look at an incident at the starting gate involving the #9 Zadra (E. Garcia 4th), #7 Up for the Hunt (C. Herrera 5th) and the #8 Omemgee (C. Belmont 7th). After reviewing the race several times and speaking to the jockeys involved, we disqualified the #9 and placed him behind the #7. The video shows the #9 bumped into the #8 who bumped into the hind end of the #7, who was beaten a ½ length for fourth place.

OBJECTION/NO CHANGE (7th Race)

Jockey KAZUSHI KIMURA, the fourth-place horse (#2 Resolve) lodged a claim of foul against the third-place horse #4 The Mizen Queen (H. Berrios) for interference approaching the finish line. After speaking to both riders involved and reviewing the video several times, we made no change to the order of finish. All three Stewards agreed that the #4 shifted out slightly, but the foul did not warrant a disqualification since the #2 was not cost a better placing.

FILM REVIEWS

Jockey EPIFANIO GARCIA and Trainer D. Wayne Baker came in to review yesterday's inquiry in the first race, in which he was disqualified from fourth to fifth place. Mr. Garcia placed part of the blame on the inside horses who shifted out slightly and stated that he made an effort to correct his horse. After hearing their arguments, the majority issued Mr. Garcia a warning. Steward Sawyer voted for a three-day suspension.

Jockey WELFIN ORANTES was in to review the fifth race (turf) from yesterday in which he shifted inward in the stretch, making hard contact with the inside horse. Mr. Orantes stated that his horse was difficult to handle and he couldn't control his horse. We believe he failed to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course by not attempting to pull the outside rein. We all agreed it was a careless riding violation, and that the incident was worthy of a three-day suspension. Therefore, the following ruling was issued.

Jockey WELFIN ORANTES who rode DE FACTO in the fifth race at Santa Anita Park on June 12, 2026, is suspended for THREE (3) racing days (June 27, 28 and July 3, 2026) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

Pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1766 (Designated Races), the term of suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races.

Jockey EDWIN MALDONADO was in our office this morning to review yesterday's twelfth race to look at an incident going into the turn (3/8's). Mr. Maldonado was on the outside of a three-horse spread when going into the turn when there was contact among three horses. He stated that the inside horse shouldn't have run up on the inside, making contact to the hind quarters of the outside horse. Stewards believe that Mr. Maldonado

being on the outside could have released some of the pressure on the horses to his inside. Warning was issued.
