**FRIDAY**8/6/21<sup>1</sup>**SOLIS LOPEZ REINSTATEMENT****Ruling #8**

Stable Foreman **Alfonso Solis Lopez** having now appeared and provided proof of completion of an in-house rehabilitation program acceptable to the Board of Stewards, is hereby restored to good standing provided he comply with the following conditions.

**Mr. Solis** shall remain on a Testing Agreement with the California Horse Racing Board, sign a contract with the Winners Foundation, maintain sobriety and remain on probation for the term of his license (11-30-2022).

The above Ruling was issued after **Mr. Solis Lopez** showed proof of rehabilitation satisfactory to the Board of Stewards and provided a clean urine sample.

8/6/21<sup>2</sup>**TOTE ISSUES**

Prior to the first race the Stewards noticed the tote board was showing very little money being wagered. Thinking it was a tote board issue, Mutuel Manager **Doug Gooby** was contacted to resolve the issue. **Mr. Gooby** said there was an issue with the tote system being set up wrong.

Since this meet is Wine Country Racing the system is supposed to be set up according to the racing fairs program which differs from Golden Gate Fields wagering format.

The mare escaped injury. Jockey **Cristobal Herrera** was taken off his remaining mount with a possible ankle sprain replaced by **Francisco Monroy**.

**CHRB VS. KUHLMANN CASE 21GG0056**

State Veterinarian **Forrest Franklin** filed a complaint through the investigators against **Kim Kuhlmann DVM** for treating a horse in the Receiving/Test Barn before obtaining permission to do so.

After a lengthy discussion concerning the protocols at the Test Barn, **Dr. Franklin** was convinced that **Dr. Kuhlmann** understood his concerns. **Dr. Franklin** stated that he felt no penalty was warranted. Case dismissed.

**7<sup>TH</sup> RACE INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION**

The Inquiry Sign was posted to review an incident at the top of the stretch concerning #5 **Dutch Painting** (**F. Alvarado**), #6 **Clockstrikestwelve** (**E. Roman**) and #7 **Avenue De France** (**FR**) (**A. Espinoza**). After review and talking to the riders involved "**Clockstrikestwelve**" who finished second was disqualified and placed sixth for interference to #5 **Dutch Painting**. #6 points for a hole that was too small and causes Jockey **Alvarado** aboard #5 to check sharply to avoid an accident. The decision was unanimous.

**PABLO FLORES RULING**

**Ruling #9**

Jockey **Pablo Flores** who rode '**Sharp Curve**' in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday, August 7, 2021, is suspended three (3) racing days August 15, 20 & 21, 2021 for violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than six (6) times during a race).

The above Ruling was issued after **Mr. Flores** reviewed the race in question with the board of Stewards and realized he went over the limit.

**EVIN ROMAN RULING (Ref 8/7/2021<sup>3</sup>)**

**Ruling #10**

Jockey **Evin Roman** who rode '**Clockstrikestwelve**' in the seventh race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday, August 7, 2021, is suspended three (3) racing days August 15, 20 & 21, 2021 for altering course entering the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from second to sixth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1699 (c) & (e) (Riding Rules-Careless Riding).

The above Ruling was issued after **Mr. Roman** reviewed the race from all angles with the Stewards. He eventually saw the error of his ways and accepted the penalty.
