HOLLENDORFER/KUHLMANN DECISIONS (REFER 06-01-2018³)**#121**

Trainer **GERALD J. HOLLENDORFER** is fined the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)* for possession of unlabeled prescription medication at his barn on March 23, 2018; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1890 (b) (Possession of Contraband).

Veterinarian **KIM L. KUHLMANN**, who treated the horse **GRECIAN FIRE**, winner of the fourth race at Golden Gate Fields on March 8, 2018 is fined the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse), for violation of California Horse Racing Board rules #1843 (a), (b) and (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances; Flumethasone, [Class 4]), #1843.1 (a) (Prohibited Drug Substances) and #1843.5 (c) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances Permitted After Entry in a Race).

Veterinarian **KIM L. KUHLMANN** is fined the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)* for dispensing an improperly labeled medication; a violation of California Horse Race Board rule #1864 (Labeling of Medications).

The above rulings were issued after the Stewards considered the evidence and testimony at the last Friday's formal hearing. At the hearing Dr. Kuhlmann admitted he mistakenly administered the Flumethasone to Grecian Fire, a horse trained by Jerry Hollendorfer. Kuhlmann took full responsibility for the resulting positive test as he gave the medication within forty-eight hours of the race. Both Kuhlmann and Hollendorfer were fined \$200.00 for an unlabeled jar of Ranitidine which Kuhlmann prescribed and Hollendorfer possessed.

\$371.7006-07-2018³**STEWARDS INQUIRY-SECOND RACE-DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to review the beginning of the 5 ½ furlong dash where the winner, #6 Miss Shirley C, ridden by Irving Orozco, shifted in on the place horse, #5 Vacaville Special with Pedro Terrero in the saddle shortly after the start. After a thorough review the Stewards, by majority vote, disqualified Miss Shirley C from first and placed her second behind Vacaville Special. Tapes of the race showed that Orozco angled his mount inward at the start and caused Vacaville Special to move off her path thereby losing the opportunity at a better placing. The margin was a nose at the wire. Jockey Orozco will view the tapes of the race with the Stewards in the morning. Steward Herbuveaux felt Terrero steered his mount inward prior to Miss Shirley C coming over and was therefore responsible for any inconvenience his mount suffered.

06-07-2018⁴**STEWARDS REVIEWS**

Two reviews were conducted during the running of today's seven race card. In the fifth race we observed #2 Please Do taking #3 Domestic Vintage wide in the first turn. Please Do didn't make the turn and packed Domestic Vintage out but the latter came back to best the former eliminating the need for any actions on the placings. Jockey Pedro Terrero will view the race with the Stewards in the morning.

In the sixth race #4 Full Flask reared at the start and broke slowly. Since the stall doors opened properly and the horse caused his own problems no action was taken.

Jockey Pedro Terrero appeared to review his ride in the fifth race where his mount was rank to place going into the Clubhouse turn and subsequently raced wide. Tapes showed Terrero was doing his best to control the horse.

Irving Orozco viewed the tapes of the second race where his mount was disqualified from first to second for interference leaving the starting gate. Orozco acknowledged he let his mount bear in shortly after the start. By majority vote (Herbiveaux dissenting) the following ruling was issued:

Jockey **IRVING OROZCO** who rode **MISS SHIRLEY C** in the second race at Golden Gate Fields on Thursday, June 7, 2018 is suspended three (3) racing days (June 15, 16 and 17, 2018) for altering course without sufficient clearance leaving the starting gate and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from first to second; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (c) & (e) (Riding Rules-careless riding). The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

06-08-2018³**FINANCIAL RESOLVED (CASE #18GG0045)**

A complaint filed by Green Valley Training Center against trainer O. J. Jauregui was settled today when O. J. brought in the final payment. Green Valley obtained a small claims judgement in the amount of \$2,969.00. Jauregui paid \$2,000.00 last week and brought the final \$969.00 today.

06-08-2018⁴**NTRA TEAM**

A National Thoroughbred Racing Association Accreditation Team has been working on the grounds this week. Headed by NTRA Executive Director Steve Cook, the team consists of Woodbine Veterinarian Greg Taylor and well-traveled Racing Official/Steward Dan Fick. The exhaustive inspection of every facet of the facility seeks to ensure that Golden Gate Fields provides the highest standards available for all participants and patrons.

06-08-2018⁵**LATE SCRATCH-FIRST RACE-REFUND**

#2 Pattyville, trained by Blaine Wright, was scratched by the Stewards while the horses were still in the paddock on the recommendation of Track Veterinarian Sarah Sporer. She reported the filly was bleeding from the nostril probably as a result of banging her head against the wall. On the Veterinarian's List. The refund amounted to \$2,964.94.

06-08-2018⁶**CLAIMS VOIDED 5TH RACE:**

#6 We're Just Saying was returned to the Andy Mathis barn after a claim dropped by Victor Trujillo was deemed void. Official Veterinarian Forest Franklin placed the horse on the Veterinarian's List after diagnosing lameness in the right front leg.

6TH RACE:

Trainer Sheldon Paldanius deposited a claim for #2 Jenuwin which was later declared void when Dr. Franklin determined the horse was unsound in the right knee and placed her on the Veterinarian's List. Jenuwin was returned to the care of Isidro Tamayo.

Trainer John Martin dropped a claim for #6 Kiss My Lulu on behalf of Owner/Trainer Ed Freeman which the Stewards voided because Martin listed himself as the new trainer which is in violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1894 (Duties of Trainer). One trainer may not train horses for another trainer. Kiss My Lulu remained under the care of William E. Morey.

Andy Mathis deposited a claim for #3 Wicked Old Fashion but Official Veterinarian Forest Franklin determined the horse was unsound on the left front and placed said horse on the Veterinarian's List. Wicked Old Fashion was returned to the barn of Victor Trujillo.

06-09-2018³**LATE SCRATCH-FIFTH RACE-REFUND**

#1 Feeling The Heat, trained by Manuel Calvario, was scratched on the recommendation of Dr. Sporer while the horses were being saddled in the paddock. Sporer reported the mare was fractious and injured herself. On the Veterinarian's List. The refund amounted to \$1,521.00.

06-09-2018⁴**LATE SCRATCH-EIGHTH RACE-REFUND**

#8 Maycee Jo, trained by Bill McLean was scratched by the Stewards after Dr. Sporer reported the filly flipped in the starting gate and was injured. On the Veterinarian's List. The refund amounted to \$95,974.48.

06-09-2018⁵**JOCKEY OBJECTION-TENTH RACE-NO CHANGE**

Jockey Alejandro Gomez aboard the show horse, #4 John Paul's Bet, lodged a claim of foul against the winner #7 Sunday Nap, ridden by Ricardo Gonzalez. Gomez alleged interference in the stretch. After a thorough review the Stewards dismissed the objection.

Tapes showed that as the two horses approached in the 1/16 John Paul's Bet drifted in while Sunday Nap stepped out. Since both horses contributed to the incident no action was taken.
