11-11-2016² **BONDE RULING**

Trainer **Jeff Bonde** is hereby fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1629 (Penalty for Late Declaration) for failure to secure valid licenses for all owners necessitating a late scratch for the horse **Miss Jo Jo** in third race on Friday, November 11, 2016; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1895 (Trainer's Duty to Insure Licensed Participation).

The above ruling was issued after Bonde took out temporary licenses for two partners on a horse when it last ran but failed to follow up and make sure the people actually applied for a license before re-entering.

11-11-2016³ **CLAIM VOIDED**

A claim deposited by trainer Tim Bellasis for the horse Cavalry in the afternoon's fifth race was deemed void by the Stewards after Official Veterinarian Forest Franklin determined the horse was lame in the right front and placed him on the Veterinarian's List. Cavalry was returned to the barn of J. B. Josephson.

Jockey **Joe Crispin** who rode **Silver Beauty** in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on Friday, November 11, 2016 is hereby fined the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00)* for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Riding Crop-used more than three times without giving the horse a chance to respond-third offense in sixty days).

The above ruling was issued after Crispin contacted the Stewards by phone and pled guilty as charged.

11-12-2016² **GARCIA RULING**

Exercise rider **Erick Gonzalez Garcia** is hereby fined the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)* for failure to follow the instructions of the Golden Gate Fields outrider on Friday, November 11, 2016; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered-galloping to close to the rail and interfering with workers).

The above ruling was released after Garcia appeared and acknowledged he was galloping a horse too close to the inside rail during morning workout hours which caused horses working along the rail to check to avoid contact. Garcia had been warned by the outriders on a previous occasion.

11-13-2016¹ **STEWARDS INQUIRY-FIRST RACE-NO CHANGE**
The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to evaluate an incident near the 1/8 which saw Kyle Frey aboard the fourth placed horse, #5 Q'Viva, steady his mount. After a thorough review the Stewards took no action with respect to the placings. Tapes showed that #1 Run Sophia Run (3rd, Abel Cedillo) stepped out near the 1/8 which floated #2 Time And Tides (2nd, Leslie Mawing) toward the middle of the track. Frey steadied his mount while being outrun so his position was not affected. Leslie Mawing will view the race tapes on Thursday.

11-13-2016² **THIRD RACE-STEWARDS INQUIRY-DISQUALIFICATION**
The inquiry lamp was lit once again after the Stewards observed Jockey Joe Crispin, aboard the fourth placed horse, #1 Papa Pagosa, steady his mount near the 1/16. After a thorough investigation the Stewards disqualified the winner, #2 Highland Lad ridden Catalino Martinez, and placed him fourth behind Papa Pagosa.

Tapes showed that Highland Lad drifted out twice in late stretch toward Papa Pagosa. The second time Crispin had to steady his mount and, in the Stewards unanimous opinion, was cost the opportunity at a better placing.

Catalino Martinez argued that #4 Reno Heat (2nd, Leslie Mawing) racing on the outside of both Crispin and Martinez contributed to the affair but the Stewards placed no blame on Reno Heat. Martinez will view the tapes of the race with the Stewards on Thursday.
