**FILM REVIEW**

Jockey Abel Cedillo appeared as requested to review the seventh race from Sunday as he allowed his mount to drift in near the 1/8 causing a rival to alter his course to the outside. The rival came on to best Cedillo's horse, but Abel was admonished to check for clearance before changing lanes.

**LATE DECLARATION**

#5 GOOD PLAYER trained by William Delia was scratched by the Stewards after the horse unseated jockey Pedro Flores and ran off. Racing Veterinarian Sara Sporer reported that the horse had injured itself and recommended the late scratch. The refund totaled \$1,035.27.

**STEWARDS INQUIRY – FIFTH RACE - DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards lit the inquiry lamp to review an incident just before the wire that saw jockey Pedro Terrero aboard the sixth place finisher #8 COMMANDER CLOUD, check his mount and lose ground. After a thorough review the Stewards

disqualified the show horse, #1 LEXIE ARLEEN ridden by Leslie Mawing, and placed him sixth behind COMMANDER CLOUD.

Tapes showed that Mawing allowed his mount to drift out in the late stages of the stretch run and take the path of a fast closing COMMANDER CLOUD. Terrero checked COMMANDER CLOUD and lost ground. The incident, in the Stewards opinion, cost COMMANDER CLOUD the opportunity at a better placing as he was beaten just a nose for fifth place. Mawing will review the tapes with the Stewards on the morrow.

**STEWARDS INQUIRY-JOCKEY OBJECTION-SEVENTH RACE-DISQUALIFICATION**

The Stewards posted the inquiry sign to evaluate contact between the first two finishers just before the finish line. The two horses were #5 RUN FOR DAYLIGHT (1<sup>st</sup>, Cristobal Herrera) and #8 KAEPERNICKING (2<sup>nd</sup>, Dennis Carr). Jockey Carr also lodged an objection. After a thorough review, the Stewards disqualified RUN FOR DAYLIGHT from the win and placed him second behind KAEPERNICKING.

Tapes showed that RUN FOR DAYLIGHT drifted in bumping and impeding KAEPERNICKING just before the wire. In the Stewards opinion the incident cost KAEPERNICKING the opportunity at the win as the margin between the two was less than a head. Herrera will review the replays with the Stewards in the morning.

**FILM REVIEW**

Jockeys Cristobal Herrera and Leslie Mawing met with the Stewards to review yesterday's races in which their mounts were disqualified. In each case the jockey admitted his horse was allowed to drift in too far without an attempt to make a correction so the following rulings were issued:

**RULING#61**

Jockey **CRISTOBAL HERRERA**, who rode **RUN FOR DAYLIGHT** in the seventh race at Golden Gate Fields on Thursday, April 2, 2015 is suspended three (3) racing days (April 10, 11 & 12, 2015) for failure to

make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from first to second. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

RULING#62

Jockey **LESLIE MAWING**, who rode **LEXIE ARLEEN** in the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields on Thursday, April 2, 2015 is suspended three (3) racing days (April 10, 11 & 12, 2015) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from third to sixth. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

**LATE SCRATCH – FOURTH RACE - REFUND**

#6 **KINGSBURY**, trained by Gloria Buckridge was scratched on the recommendation of racing veterinarian Sara Sporer, DVM, at six minutes to post after she reported the gelding was off in the left hind during the warm up period. On Vet's List, the refund amounted to \$3,464.53.

**CLAIM VOIDED – FIFTH RACE**

A claim deposited by trainer Tim Bellasis for the horse THANKS A MILLION was voided after official veterinarian Forrest Franklin, DVM, reported the horse was unsound and placed him on the Vet's List. The horse was returned to the barn of trainer Rodney Cone.

**LATE SCRATCH – EIGHTH RACE - REFUND**

#7 **THRU THE AGES**, trained by Jerry Hollendorfer was scratched on the recommendation of official veterinarian Forrest Franklin, DVM, after he stated the horse developed a spot of colic and was treated. On Vet's List, the refund totaled \$3,730.99.
