The Cal-bred race for three year old fillies, one mile, claiming \$14,000 - \$16,000., failed to fill.

01-23-15³**RULING NO.16 – R.B. HESS SR. (CASE #14GG0121)**

Trainer **R.B. HESS SR.**, who started the horse **HEAT MAKER**, winner of the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields on December 14, 2014, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00)* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Phenylbutazone – in excess of permitted level 6.76 ug/ml [Class 4]).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Hess accepted responsibility for what he believes was a mix up at his barn. The veteran trainer has an excellent record without any medication violations for many years.

01-23-15⁴**ACCIDENT – 5TH RACE**

Following the running of the fifth race #7 JACKSON STRUTT (Tr. Ronda Davis) attempted to exit the track through the 7/8 gap. The three year old gelding hit the gap gate and unseated jockey Maicol Severino. An accident report is attached to these minutes.

01-23-15⁵**JOCKEY SEARCHED**

The CHRB Investigative staff conducted a body search of jockey Silvio Amador prior to the start of the eighth race. No contraband was discovered and the race proceeded without further delay.

01-24-15³**RULING #17 – UZZIEL MANRIQUEZ (CASE 15GG0005)**

Stable Foreman **UZZIEL MANRIQUEZ**, pursuant to CHRB rule #1529 (Referral to the Board), is hereby summarily suspended the matter referred to the California Horse Racing Board, pending further order of the Board, to answer charges alleging violation of CHRB rules #1489 (g) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License), #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations) and #1874 (1) (2) and (4) (Disorderly Conduct).

The above ruling was issued upon receipt of a CHRB Investigative Report and complaint regarding a felony domestic violence matter that resulted in Mr. Manriquez' arrest.

01-24-15⁴**SILVIO AMADOR (REFER 1-23/15⁵)**

Jockey Silvio Amador and his agent Fernando Navarro met with the Board of Stewards regarding the incident prior to yesterday's eighth race. The Board of Stewards informed the two, who were upset, that the procedure was initiated by the CHRB Investigative Staff.

01-24-15⁵**CLAIM VOIDED – 8th RACE**

The claim submitted by trainer Jack Steiner for #1 GIANT JOURNEY (second) was voided by the Board of Stewards upon the report by State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin DVM, that the five year old mare was lame in the right foreleg. GIANT JOURNEY was returned to the Jeff Metz barn.
