Jockey **JUAN ARRIAGA** is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00)* for failure to ride his mount in the first race at the Big Fresno Fair (Fresno) on Monday, October 13, 2014; a violation of California Horse Racing Board Rule #1872 (Failure to Fulfill Jockey Agreement).

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Arriaga called the Stewards and failed to provide a valid reason for missing his riding assignment.

10-16-14⁴**VOID CLAIM - 2ND RACE**

A claim submitted prior to the 2nd race for #7 POWERFUL was deemed void after the horse was examined following the race and was placed on the Veterinarian's List for unsoundness. The horse was returned to the stable of John Martin.

Following the running of the 7th race a claim submitted for #9 GUTSHOT STRAIGHT was voided after the horse was placed on the Veterinarian's List for unsoundness. The horse was returned to the R.B. Hess barn.

A hearing was scheduled to address California Horse Racing Board complaint #14GG00100 filed against Assistant Trainer Lisa Dezotell for alleged violation of CHRB Rules #1405 (Punishment by the Board), #1407 (Extensions for Compliance) and #1489 (h) and (j) (Grounds for Denial or Refusal of License).

The hearing was originally scheduled to be heard on October 9, 2014 at the Fresno District Fair. At the time, Ms. Dezotell requested a later date to allow her time to prepare for the hearing. That request was granted with today's date and time which was agreed on by all parties. Ms. Dezotell phoned earlier this morning and stated that she was in Sacramento and would be a little late. It was obvious she was going to be late as the call was made around 9:30 a.m. with the hearing scheduled for 10:30 a.m.

After an hour wait, the court reporter and the witness were dismissed. Ms. Dezotell appeared about fifteen minutes later and stated that she was delayed in traffic. Decision to follow.

Having discharged the outstanding financial obligation to San Francisco Equine the license privileges of Owner Kevin Paul Koentopp (d.b.a. Koentopp Farms) are eligible to be restored to good standing and Pacific Racing Association ruling #37 dated February 24, 2012 suspending Mr. Koentopp for violation of CHRB rule #1547 (Failure to Appear) is hereby set aside.

The preceding ruling was issued after the Stewards received documentation from Bankruptcy Court, District of Nevada whereby Mr. and Mrs. Koentopp were granted a discharge from the debt owed to San Francisco Equine.

10-19-14⁴ **6th RACE - INQUIRY**
The Inquiry sign was posted following the running of the 6th race for a review of the actions of #2 FLY BEYOND (4th place – jockey Juan Hernandez) near the eighth pole marker. After reviewing the recorded views of the incident no change was made to the order of finish.

The recordings show #2 veer out sharply into the path of #7 JAXON'SCOUSINOWEN (2nd place – jockey Alejandro Gomez) forcing the rider of #7 to check off heels with No placing affected. The decision was unanimous.
