04-19-14³ **GUMARO Z. MENA (14GG0033)**

A formal hearing was held this morning for Association employee (Outrider) Gumaro Z. Mena, who has been charged with alleged violation of California Horse Racing Board Rules #1481, #1530, #1581.1 (b), #1887 (a) and #1902 (c).

Present for the hearing, in addition to the Board of Stewards and Mr. Mena, were his wife Gullermina G. Mena and CHRB Investigator Louis Quezada, who presented the case. Mr. Mena waived his right to counsel and requested that his wife be present and interpret for him as he is not fluent in the English language. CSR Christine Niccoli recorded the proceedings.

Extensive testimony was presented and due to time constraints the hearing could not be completed and will resume on a date to be determined.

04-19-14⁴ **RULING #58 – BRADFORD RUDOLPH (14GG0013)**

In the matter of:
Owner Bradford Rudolph

Having failed to abide by the terms of a signed payment agreement with Equine Sports Medicine and Surgery owner Bradford Rudolph is hereby suspended for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1876 (Financial Responsibility) pending satisfaction of the outstanding obligation.

The foregoing ruling was issued after the Board of Stewards were notified by Lynnette Thompson (Bookkeeper for Equine Sports Medicine) that Bradford Rudolph has failed to submit the payment (\$433.34) due on April 7, 2014. Mr. Rudolph signed a payment agreement to satisfy the financial complaint filed against him.

04-19-14⁵ **INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – 3rd RACE**

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the third race for a review of the stretch run. After interviewing the riders, considering the patrol judges report and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to make the original order of finish official.

The video shows a three horse spread with #2 FREE MONEY (Jockey- Russell Baze) first, on the inside, #6 ORNERY STRIKE (Jockey- Frank Alvarado, second on the outside) and #4 GOOD PROOF (Jockey – Ricardo Gonzalez) sixth, between those two. There was slight jostling among those three that had no bearing on the outcome.

04-19-14⁶ **HORSE PULLED UP – 4th RACE**
 #2 OLYMPIO GOLD (Tr. Ellen Jackson) was rank and pulled up near the 4 ½ pole by jockey Diego Sanchez. Track Veterinarian Sara Sporer found nothing physically wrong with the four year old gelding. The horse will be placed on the Stewards List.

04-19-14⁷ **CLAIM VOIDED – 6th RACE**
 The Board of Stewards voided the claim submitted by John Martin for #1 PASEO ALEGRO after being notified by State Veterinarian Forrest Franklin that the seven Year old gelding was lame in the left foreleg and the left hind. PASEO ALEGRO was returned to the Jerry Hollendorfer barn.
