RULING NO. 61 – JOCKEY JULIEN COUTON

Jockey **JULIEN COUTON** who rode AS GOOD AS GOLD in the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields on Sunday, April 28, 2013 is suspended five (5) racing days May 9, 10, 11, 12 and 16, 2013 for moving through an opening along the rail in the stretch without sufficient clearance and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from fourth to sixth. A violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – Careless Riding).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Couton met with the stewards for a review of the sixth race from Sunday, April 28, 2013.

Mr. Couton acknowledged he was over aggressive in attempting to drive inside horses along the rail without sufficient room.

5-2-13⁴ **OBJECTION – NO CHANGE – 7th RACE**

The Stewards conducted an inquiry following the seventh race at the request of jockey Russell Baze who rode #1 TRUMPET PLAYER JAY, second. Mr. Baze lodged a claim of foul against the winner #2 LORNEFIVEHUNDRED (jockey – Catalino Martinez).

After interviewing the riders involved, the patrol judges and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to make the original order of finish official. The video shows both horses contributed to the minor contact in the stretch.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Greiner met with the Stewards regarding his failure to perform his duty as the 3/8 tower cameraman during the running of a race. Mr. Greiner, a very capable employee, was apologetic and stated he was ill on that day and just dozed off.

5-4-13³ **INQUIRY – DISQUALIFICATION – 9th RACE**

The Stewards conducted an inquiry following the ninth race for a review of an incident in the stretch involving the first three finishers.

After consulting with the patrol judges, interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the video, the Stewards decided unanimously to disqualify #9 TRIPLE ACTION (jockey – William Antongeorgi III) from first to third, for causing interference near the 1/16 pole.

The video shows #9 TRIPLE ACTION drift out, under left handed whipping, jump and impede #8 RENZO SEAN (jockey – Alejandro Gomez), second, who in turn bumped and impeded #6 FUNNY HOW (jockey – Dennis Carr) third.

Jockey **WILLIAM ANTONGEORGI III**, who rode **TRIPLE ACTION** in the ninth race at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday, May 4, 2013 is suspended three (3) racing days (May 12, 16 and 17, 2013) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from first to third. A violation of California Horse

Racing Board rule 1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Antongeorgi met with the Stewards for a review of the ninth race.

Mr. Antongeorgi was very candid in acknowledging he was simply trying too hard to win and accepted the penalty imposed.
