**RULING NO. 53 – JOCKEY ANTHONY M. AYALA**

Jockey Anthony M. Ayala, having complied with the terms of Pacific Racing Association ruling #18 dated November 22, 2012 is hereby restored to good standing. Mr. Ayala is placed on probation for the term of his license (3-31-2014) and must abide by the terms of a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board and a contract with the Winners Foundation.

The above ruling was issued after Mr. Ayala appeared and produced a copy of a contract with the Winners Foundation and signed a testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board. Ayala also submitted a urine sample which, according to the field test, was negative for controlled substances. The sample will be sent to Quest Laboratory for final confirmation.

4-18-13<sup>3</sup> **LATE DECLARATION – THIRD RACE- REFUND**  
#1 CHARMING BESS, trained by Frances Henderson, was scratched on the recommendation of Track Veterinarian Sara Sporer, D.V.M. when she diagnosed the filly as off on the right front during the warm up. On Vet's List. The refund amounted to \$293.58.

4-18-13<sup>4</sup> **LATE SCRATCH – SEVENTH RACE – REFUND**  
#5 DANCING TWILIGHT, trained by Sam DiLaura, was declared on the advice of Dr. Sara Sporer, D.V.M. who reported the filly was unsound. On Vet's List. The refund Totalled \$25,638.05.

Trainer Mike Larson, who started the horse He's Cagey, second place finisher in the third race at Golden Gate Fields on February 23, 2013, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: unapproved Medication; Carbazochrome [Class 4]).

The above ruling was issued after Larson contacted the Stewards, by phone, and waived his right to a formal hearing. Larson acknowledged his vet, Dr. Boyer, administered the medication, also known as Kentucky Red, over 48 hours prior to the race. The substance was given with vitamins and is used to help with problem bleeders.

4-19-13<sup>3</sup> **LATE SCRATCH – 8<sup>th</sup> RACE- REFUND**  
#3 I'LLFLYTOKY, trained by Thomas Valenzuela, was scratched on Dr. Sara Sporer's recommendation. Shortly before the field reached the starting gate she reported the mare failed to warm up properly. On Vet's list. The refund was \$23,113.28.

The above ruling was issued after Feron explained he didn't hear the five minute call from the Receiving Barn.

**4-21-13<sup>2</sup> ASSISTANT TRAINER MARY PANIAN – RULING NO. 56**

Assistant Trainer Mary Panian, is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for failure to obey the outriders during morning workout hours; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1870 (Conditions of Meeting Binding upon Licensees).

The above ruling was issued after Panian, along with the morning outriders, Bobby Anderson and Nancy Barney met with the Stewards. The outriders objected to Panian and the way she constantly backtracked her horses in the morning. Panian stated she did jog the wrong way with one horse every so often, but the outriders said she has galloped the wrong way with numerous horses on numerous occasions and had previously been warned.

**4-21-13<sup>3</sup> TRAINER TERRI EATON – RULING NO. 57**

Trainer Terri Eaton, who started the horse INVISIBLE HEAT, second place finisher in the fourth race at Golden Gate Fields on March 3, 2013, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (500.00)\* pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of CHRB rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Unapproved Medication; Carbazochrome [Class 4]).

The above ruling was issued after Eaton appeared, signed a waiver to a formal hearing and accepted the penalty imposed. Eaton does not agree with the premise that she is the responsible party for the test results as the medication was administered by her attending veterinarian with her permission but she chose not to contest the allegations as a matter of convenience.

4-21-13<sup>4</sup> **LATE SCRATCH – THIRD RACE – REFUND**

#6 YOU'RE A NATION, trained by Roger Stein, was scratched on the recommendation of Dr. Sara Sporer after she reported the filly flipped in the starting gate during the loading process and injured herself. On Vet's List. The refund totaled \$30,321.69.
