##### **09-05-12<sup>3</sup> RULING NO. 3 – VALLEJO**

Trainer **GENARO VALLEJO** is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for reporting late to the receiving barn with the horse PLATINUM RULES prior to the eighth race on Monday, September 3, 2012; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1852 (Reporting to Receiving Barn).

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Vallejo met with the stewards and failed to provide an excusable reason for his horse being late to the receiving barn and to the saddling paddock.

##### **09-05-12<sup>4</sup> RULING NO. 4 – RODRIGUEZ**

Apprentice Jockey **FREDDY RODRIGUEZ**, who rode **DOWN TOWN CLYDE** in the tenth race at Golden Gate Fields on Monday, September 3, 2012, is suspended five (5) racing days (September 14, 15, 16, 20 and 21,

2012) for failure to make the proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference resulting in the disqualification of his mount from second to fifth; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Rodriguez met with this Board, reviewed the race and acknowledged making the mistake of not correcting his mount's course as quickly as needed to keep from causing interference. This was Mr. Rodriguez's second suspension within thirty days therefore five suspension days were issued.
