08-20-11¹ **CAL-BRED REPORT**

The Cal-bred race for fillies and mares, three years old and older, claiming price \$5,000, one mile, failed to fill.

08-20-11² **GEGORY B. LATTERI** (Case #11GG0188)

Owner **Gregory B. Latteri** failed to appear to address a financial complaint filed against him by San Francisco Equine, Inc., alleging overdue vet bills totaling \$4,600.00.

No ruling will be issued by this Board of Stewards as Mr. Latteri is currently suspended for failing to appear before the Los Alamitos Board of Stewards to address another financial complaint (Los Alamitos ruling #158, dated 8-12-11).

This current complaint (11GG0188) will be added to Mr. Latteri's California Horse Racing Board license record and must be addressed upon his reinstatement at Los Alamitos.

08-20-11³ **RULING NO. 1 – MARTINEZ**

Jockey **CATALINO MARTINEZ**, who rode **SOLD SHORT** in the fourth race at the Sonoma County Fair (Santa Rosa) on Sunday, August 14, 2011, is suspended three (3) racing days (August 28, September 2

and 3, 2011) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course and causing interference down the backstretch; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The foregoing was issued following a film review with Mr. Martinez. The veteran jockey acknowledged he erred in altering course and causing interference.

08-20-11⁴ **EARLY START – Ninth Race**

The field for the ninth race was dispatched approximately thirty seconds before the listed post time for this five and one half furlong event.

It appears there was confusion at the gate as #4 STORM'S END had unseated his jockey (Pedro Flores) and ran off. After being caught in the three quarter chute, the colt was brought back to the gate to be examined by the track vet, Sara Sporer, D.V.M.

After Dr. Sporer cleared the horse to run, he was led into the gate with the rest of the field hustling up to the gate, immediately loaded and sent on their way.

08-21-11³ **FILM REVIEW**

Jockey's Juan Hernandez (6th race) and Geovanni Franco (7th race) met with the stewards to review their respective races. Both riders were warned to keep their mounts on a straight course in the stretch.

08-21-11⁴ **STARTER TODD STEPHENS** (Refer: 08-20-11⁴)

The stewards met with starter Todd Stephens regarding the premature start of yesterday's ninth race.

Mr. Stephens was advised that even though he had a problem horse (#4 STORM'S END), no horses should be loaded into the gate prior to post time.

Outrider Nancy Barney was also advised by the Board of Stewards not to get the horses to the starting gate prior to post time.

08-21-11⁵ **INQUIRY – NO CHANGE – First Race**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign following the first race for a review of an incident in the stretch involving #3 CAROLINE ELENA (Kyle Frey), the winner, and #5 GREAT AUNT NORA, who finished second.

After reviewing the video, talking to the riders involved and considering the patrol judge's report, the stewards decided unanimously to let the original order of finish stand.

The video shows both horses raced wide for most of the six furlong event and then both drifted out together in the stretch.
