Sunday**03-13-11¹ CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$9,000. For California bred or California sired four year olds and upward that have not won an open claiming race or started for \$8,000 or more in their last start, claiming price \$4,000, five and one half furlongs. This race was called off with two entries.

03-13-11³ INQUIRY – Second Race – NO CHANGE

The inquiry sign was lit following the running of the second race for a review of observed interference near the 5/8 pole involving #2 GREY ALYCATT (6th, Aaron Gryder) and #1 BIG COZZ (3rd, Francisco Duran).

After reviewing the incident the race was made official.

The recording shows #2 run off after being rank to place and crossover into the path of #1 forcing the rider of #1 to take up and lose position. #1 placed in front of the offending horse; therefore, no action was taken.

03-13-11⁴ **INQUIRY / OBJECTION – Sixth Race – NO CHANGE**

The inquiry sign was posted following the running of the sixth race for a review of contact between #4 GREEK ANGELS (3rd, Kevin Krigger) and #5 (7th, Pedro Flores) at the head of the stretch. In addition to the stewards inquiry jockey Russell Baze, rider of second place finisher #2 SWISS EDITOR M D, lodged a claim of foul against the winner, #1a MOONS PRIDE, ridden by jockey Aaron Gryder for alleged interference through the stretch.

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the incidents the numbers posted were made official.

In reviewing the incident at the head of the stretch the recording shows #4, lacking racing room behind horses, alter course outward and make contact with #5 to obtain a clear path. In the stewards' opinion the incident did not alter placing; therefore, no change was made to the order of finish.

The objection was not allowed after the recording showed both horses racing tightly against each other with neither horse causing interference to the level that would require disqualification.

03-17-11³ **RULING NO. 39 – KRIGGER**

Jockey **KEVIN KRIGGER**, who rode **GREEK ANGELS** in the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields on Sunday, March 13, 2011, is suspended three (3) racing days (March 24, 25 and 26, 2011) for altering course without sufficient clearance in the stretch and causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Krigger met with the stewards, reviewed the race and failed to provide a persuasive argument that he was not at fault. Mr. Krigger placed blame on the horse on his outside; however, the recordings clearly show Mr. Krigger alter his course and make contact with the outside horse on two occasions.

03-17-11⁴ **TRAINER OSBALDO G. JAUREGUI HEARING**

An informal hearing was held to address CHRB complaint 11GG0004 filed against Mr. Jauregui as a result of a phenylbutazone overage of 8.71 ug/ml on a horse that was working to get off the veterinarian list. Mr. Jauregui pled guilty with an explanation of a possible feed tub mix up. Ruling to follow.

03-18-11³ **RULING NO. 40 – STANSFIELD**

Trainer **CHARLES E. STANSFIELD**, who started the horse **FEVER RELIEVER**, second place finisher in the first race at Golden Gate Fields on January 29, 2011, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to

Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843(a) & (d) (Medication, Drugs and Other Substances: Prohibited Substance – Dexamethasone – [Class 4]).

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Stansfield met with the stewards, acknowledged guilt and stated he has another horse in his barn being treated with Azium (the parent drug for dexamethasone) and apparently this horse was mistakenly treated with the medication.

03-18-11⁴ **RULING NO. 41 - CORBITT**

Groom **RICHARD CORBITT**, having complied with the term of Pacific Racing Association ruling #11 dated January 11, 2007, is hereby deemed eligible for re-licensing.

As a condition of licensing, CORBITT shall abide by the terms of a signed testing agreement with the California Horse Racing Board and with the terms of a contract with the Winners Foundation. Any violation of the terms of the testing agreement or the Winners Foundation contract may be cause for the immediate suspension of Corbitt's license privileges.

The foregoing ruling was issued after Mr. Corbitt and Nora Lee (Winners Foundation representative) met with the stewards and provided a copy of the signed contract agreement between the two parties which brought Mr. Corbitt in compliance with the terms and condition of Pacific Racing Association ruling issued on January 11, 2007.

03-18-11⁵ **INQUIRY – Third Race**

As the horses passed the finish line for the third race the inquiry was posted for a review of the start involving #5 SAMMY CHOI (3rd, Russell Baze).

After a thorough review the race was made official.

The recorded views show #5 becomes fractious prior to the start, charge the gate as the field was sent on its way and break awkwardly while breaking on the lead. Mr. Baze was unprepared for the start, broke on the horse's mouth and lost an iron before catching his balance and regaining the lost iron. Pursuant to CHRB rule 1696 (The Start) #5 was determined to be a starter as the slow motion of the head on view shows the gates open simultaneously.
