10-31-10³ **OBJECTION – NO CHANGE – Seventh Race**

Following the running of the seventh race jockey Hector Romero, rider of second place finisher #5 ROMAN LADY, lodged an objection against the winner #7 LOGICAL SINGLE (Juan Hernandez) for interference near the 1/16 pole.

After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the recorded views the results posted were made official.

The recordings show #7 drift out while being just clear of #5 as that rival shifts in for a clear path.

11-03-10¹ **CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$11,200. For California bred or California sired fillies and mares, three years old and upward, claiming price \$8,000 at six furlongs. The race failed to receive an entry and was called off.

11-03-10² **RULING NO. 6 – LOPEZ**

Jockey **DAVID G. LOPEZ**, who rode **HEARDABIRD** in the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields on Sunday, October 31, 2010, is suspended three (3) racing days (November 10, 11 and 12, 2010) for failure to make a proper effort to maintain a straight course in the stretch and causing interference; a violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1699 (d) & (f) (Riding Rules – careless riding).

The term of this suspension shall not prohibit participation in designated races in California.

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Lopez reviewed the race with the stewards and candidly acknowledged he was trying too hard and failed to correct his mount when it started drifting off course.

11-03-10³ **JUAN HERNANDEZ FILM REVIEW**

Jockey **Juan Hernandez** accompanied by his agent, Ramon Silva, were in to review the seventh race from Sunday's races. After reviewing all the recorded views a stern warning was issued to allow more clearance if he is going to allow his mount to drift off its course.

11-03-10⁴ **TRAINER BILL MOREY, JR. FILM REVIEW**

Trainer **BILL MOREY, JR.** came in to review the final sixteenth of Sunday's seventh race. After reviewing the various recorded views and listening to his analysis, all parties respectfully agreed to disagree.

11-03-10⁶ **HORSE COLLAPSES**

During the running of the second race while racing near the rear of the field at the 1/16 pole, #1 TOP OF THE LIST, ridden by jockey Juan Hernandez, lost its action behind and collapsed. Jockey Hernandez jumped off the horse before the horse landed and was uninjured.

Track Veterinarian Heather Kerr was immediately on the scene to attend the horse and reported soon thereafter the horse died of what appears to be a heart attack. The horse will be transported to University of Davis for necropsy.

11-04-10¹ **CAL-BRED REPORT**

Purse \$18,000. For California bred or California sired fillies, two years old, claiming price \$16,000 at six furlongs. Only three entries were received for the race and the race was called off.

11-04-10² **RULING NO. 7 – PEREZ**

Jockey **MIGUEL A. PEREZ** is fined the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1680 (Jockey and Drivers to Report) on Wednesday, November 3, 2010.

The ruling listed above was issued after Mr. Perez met with the stewards and failed to offer a valid reason for failing to report to the jockeys' room on time.

11-04-10³ **RULING NO. 8 – VALLEJO**

Trainer **GENARO VALLEJO**, who started the horse CHIEF LITTLE MAN, winner of the sixth race at Golden Gate Fields on September 2, 2010, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843(a) & (d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances: More than one approved NSAID – Phenylbutazone and Flunixin – Class 4).

The preceding ruling was issued after Mr. Vallejo met with the stewards to address CHRB complaint 10GG0201 and requested to address the matter to be handled informally. Mr. Vallejo was at a loss as to how the horse received both medications but surmised a mistake was made by his attending veterinarian.

The recordings show the rider of #1 check his mount after going for an opening along the rail, inside #5 SENIOR CITIZEN (1st place, Inoel Beato) and #3 VEGAS THIEF (3rd place, Pedro Flores) with the opening closing prior to #1's arrival.
