CAL-BRED REPORT

Purse \$8,400. Fillies and Mares, three years old and upward, claiming price \$5,000, six furlongs, failed to fill with three (3) entries.

DAVID LOPEZ FILM REVIEW (Ref: 09-25-10⁶)

Jockey **David Lopez** appeared in the stewards' office to review his ride in yesterday's (Sept. 25) ninth race. Jockey Lopez rode first place finisher #3 CAPITAL CAT. He survived a claim of foul that was lodged following the race by jockey Russell Baze who was aboard second place finisher #9 VELIKAYA.

Inside the final sixty yards, #3 CAPITOL CAT drifts out and brushes #9 VELIKAYA. Jockey Lopez acknowledged he slightly came off his straight course in this race's final stages. The stewards unanimously felt this ride fell just short of warranting a suspension. Jockey Lopez was told however a duplication of this ride would likely result in a penalty. Warning issued.

CARLOS DIAZ FILM REVIEW (Ref: 9-25-10⁴)

Apprentice jockey **Carlos Diaz** appeared in the stewards' office to review his first ride at Golden Gate Fields after arriving here from Oklahoma. Tony Landeros helped out by serving as an interpreter.

Apprentice Diaz was aboard #2 WORLD OF COLOR who finished eleventh (last) in yesterday's (September 25) fourth race. Apprentice Diaz lodged a claim of foul against ninth place finisher #7 MO STEAM (Julien Couton) for alleged interference at the ¼ pole. There was also a stewards' inquiry in this race.

The stewards unanimously felt it was the actions of Diaz' mount #2 WORLD OF COLOR (lugging out over rival's heels) that led to a heel clipping incident at the ¼ pole. After

film review, apprentice Diaz understood that he was not fouled by another horse and/or rider in this race.

09-26-10⁴ **GUSTAVO ORTIZ FILM REVIEW**

Apprentice jockey **Gustavo Ortiz** appeared in the stewards' office with interpreter Augustine Meza. Apprentice Ortiz rode first place finisher #7 HI AND GOODBYE in yesterday's (September 25) fifth race.

At the start HI AND GOODBYE breaks inward quite sharply as apprentice Ortiz was very aggressive away from the gate. Fortunately for Ortiz was the fact that inside rival #6 STORM FLASH (Pedro Flores) dwelt at the start. Ortiz' efforts at the start will be monitored closely. Warning issued.

Apprentice jockey **Gustavo Ortiz** appeared in the stewards' office accompanied by interpreter Augustine Meza. Apprentice Ortiz was ordered to film review in order to watch the seventh race from yesterday (September 30). In this one mile and one-sixteen turf race Ortiz was aboard #7 MARIAH MARINA, who finished seventh. Race replays show MARIAH MARINA lug out at the ¼ pole and bump eventual tenth place finisher #10 BEST OF THE BUNCH (Catalino Martinez).

Ortiz stated he saw an opening and then went for it at this juncture. While this incident alone was not suspension worthy, repeated appearances in the stewards' office could be.

Purse \$12,500. Fillies and Mares, three years old and upward, claiming price \$12,500 - \$10,500, six furlongs, was called off with four (4) entries.

10-02-10²**RULING NO. 23 – SILVA**

Jockey Agent **JUAN RAMON SILVA** is fined the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1530 (Cases Not Covered by Rules and Regulations) for failure to conduct his business in a proper manner on Thursday, September 30, 2010.

Jockey Agent **Ramon Silva** and trainer **O. J. Jauregui** appeared in the stewards' office yesterday. Trainer Jauregui felt he was given a 'call' that was not honored by agent Silva. Following questioning from the stewards, it was determined that agent Silva gave out two 'calls' for jockey Juan Hernandez in the seventh race Sunday, October 3rd (closing day). The three (3) stewards unanimously agreed to issue the ruling listed above.

10-02-10³**OFFICIAL CHANGES**

Placing Judge Steve Martinelli is off today for personal reasons. Veteran racing official C. Gregory Brent, Jr., will fill in. Patrol Judge Josh Wyatt is off today for personal reasons. Racing Official Jamie Martin will fill in.

10-02-10⁴**INQUIRY – Seventh Race – NO CHANGE**

The stewards posted the inquiry sign to review the start of this five and one-half furlong maiden two (2) year old filly race.

Of particular investigation were the actions of third place finisher #1 LIFE'S A THRILL (Julien Couton) and first place finisher #6 JUSTENUFAPPEAL (Frank Alvarado). #1 LIFE'S A THRILL broke out sharply. #6 JUSTENUFAPPEAL breaks in slightly, bumps his inside rival and is tipped inward.

The stewards reviewed several replay angles and received a patrol judge report. The horses most affected in this incident were seventh place finisher #3 PEARL LAKE (Inoel Beato), eighth place finisher #4 SILVERADA (Carlos Diaz) and tenth place finisher #5 BLAZINGLY (Luis Martinez).

In a unanimous decision the stewards ruled that neither the actions of #1 LIFE'S A THRILL nor #6 JUSTENUFAPPEAL rose to the level of a disqualification. No change.
