06-04-10² **RULING NO. 87 - PITNICK** (10GG110)

Trainer **BRIAN J. PITNICK**, who started the horse DOUBLE EXCESSO, winner of the fifth race at Golden Gate Fields on April 3, 2010, is fined the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) pursuant to California Horse Racing Board rule #1887 (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse) for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1843 (a) & (d) (Medications, Drugs and Other Substances: Unauthorized Substance -

Dexamethasone [Class 4]).

The foregoing ruling was issued following the hearing held for Mr. Pitnick on May 29, 2010. During that hearing Mr. Pitnick acknowledged a therapeutic treatment of Dexamethasone (Voren) at least fifty hours prior to race time, by his veterinarian, Ashton Cloninger, D.V.M.

06-04-10³ **RULING NO. 88 – LEWIS** (10LA0010)

In the matter of:

Assistant Trainer **BILLY G. LEWIS**

The license privileges of Billy G. Lewis having now been restored to good standing in the state of Texas, Pacific Racing Association ruling No. 51, dated March 21, 2010, suspending Lewis for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1484 (Evidence of Unfitness for License) is hereby set aside and Lewis is restored to good standing in California.

The above ruling was issued as the stewards are in receipt of documents from the Texas Racing Commission that Mr. Lewis has been restored to good standing in that jurisdiction. As there are no other issues pending against Mr. Lewis, he is hereby restored to good standing in California.

06-04-10⁴ **FORMAL HEARING – Hector Romero** (09GG313)

A formal hearing was held for jockey Hector Romero, who has been charged with an alleged violation of the terms of his conditional license, specifically California Horse Racing Board rules #1900 (Grounds for Suspension or Revocation) and #1485(d) (License Subject to Conditions and Agreements).

Present, in addition to the Board of Stewards were Mr. Romero, his counsel, James Ghidella, Esq., Armando Calero (Winners Foundation) and CHRB senior investigator Charles Smith, who presented the case. Court Reporter Christine Niccoli recorded the proceedings.

The complaint, as alleged, indicates “that on March 26, 2010, Hector Romero was convicted for violation of California Vehicle Code Sections 23152(a) & (b) and 23550. Romero had a conditional jockey license and violated the conditions set forth in SAC 08-0029”.

The facts of the case are not in dispute, nor are the terms of Mr. Romero’s conditional license.

After receipt of testimonial and documentary evidence the hearing was closed.
