- Races:** Eight races weekdays, nine races Opening Day and weekends, unless otherwise designated.
- Post time:** Wednesday October 6, 2010, 1:00 p.m.; Thursdays 1:00 p.m. except October 21 and 28: 7:00 p.m. Friday Night Racing 7:00 p.m. except October 1 and 15, 2010.
- Scratch time:** 10:00 a.m. previous day deadline for scratches for overnight races and overnight stakes races. Scratch time for regular stakes is prior to the 3<sup>rd</sup> race on race day.
- Wagering:** Minimum \$2 win, place and show wagering on every race; \$2 Rolling Doubles; \$1 Rolling Pick Threes; \$1 Exactas on all races; \$1 Trifectas; \$1 and 10 cent Superfectas on all qualifying races; \$1 Pick Four on final four races; \$1 Pick Five on final five races; \$2 Pick Six (with carryover) on final six races, and \$1 Place Pick All (no carryover) beginning with first race.
- Auxiliary:** Fairplex Park and San Luis Rey Downs.

**RULING OTTH #001**

Jockey **MARTIN GARCIA** is fined **THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)\*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Whips-causing welts or breaks in skin) during the running of the seventh race at Del Mar Race Track on August 25, 2010.

This ruling was issued after Garcia responded to a complaint filed by the Board alleging that he left a horse welted following the seventh race at Del Mar on August 25, 2010. When Liberian Freighter, ridden by Garcia, arrived in the Receiving Barn following the race, Official Veterinarian Jill Bailey observed a large welt on the right flank.

Mr. Garcia, who has not had a whip violation in nearly two years, was contrite, stating that he has been working hard to make sure he does not hit his mounts in the flank.

**RULING OTTH #003**

Jockey **JOSEPH TALAMO** is fined **THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00)\*** for violation of California Horse Racing Board rule #1688 (Use of Whips-causing welts or breaks in skin) during the running of the second race at Del Mar Race Track on July 30, 2010.

This ruling was issued after the rider had viewed photographs and video from the second race at Del Mar, during which he cut his mount in the right flank during the stretch run. The case was held over as Talamo was injured a few days later and missed the remainder of the Del Mar meeting.

Talamo, who last had a whip infraction over a year ago, was surprised when he saw the video. He had not realized that he was hitting the horse in the flank area.

**COMPLAINTS SETTLED**

Two financial complaints filed by veterinarian Amy Nevens were adjudicated as both licensees agreed to monthly payments and will sign financial agreements.

**REFUND**

A refund was ordered in the seventh race as #3 Rinterval flipped during the saddling procedure, injured itself, and was declared on the recommendation of Racing Veterinarian Stead. The refund amounted to \$73,138.67.

A minus pool was created in the seventh race when the great race mare, the undefeated Zenyatta, kept her record intact with a stirring half length victory in the Lady's Secret Stakes. The amount needed to balance came to \$151,771.44.
