CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS TITLE 4. BUSINESS REGULATIONS DIVISION 4. CALIFORNIA HORSE RACING BOARD ARTICLE 16. GENERAL CONDUCT PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF RULE 1875, FIREARMS

1875. Firearms Weapons and Ammunition.

No licensee, employee of the association or its concessionaires, shall possess a firearm the following while on the grounds of a facility within the purview or control of the Board unless such possession has been authorized by state or federal law, and unless the documentation of such authorization is on his or her person.:

- (1) A firearm or any ammunition unless such possession has been authorized by state or federal law, and unless the documentation of such authorization is on his or her person.
- (2) Any device or instrument that expels a projectile, such as a BB or pellet, through the force of air pressure, gas pressure or spring action.
- (3) Any non-powder gun (NPG) device, such as an airsoft gun, not limited to: BB gun, pellet gun, spot marker gun, paint ball gun, taser gun, or stun gun.
