PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF RULE 1875, FIREARMS

1875. ~~Firearms~~Weapons and Ammunition.

No licensee, employee of the association or its concessionaires, shall possess ~~a firearm~~ the following while on the grounds of a facility within the purview or control of the Board ~~unless such possession has been authorized by state or federal law, and unless the documentation of such authorization is on his or her person.;~~

- (1) A firearm or any ammunition unless such possession has been authorized by state or federal law, and unless the documentation of such authorization is on his or her person.
- (2) Any device or instrument that expels a projectile, such as a BB or pellet, through the force of air pressure, gas pressure or spring action.
- (3) Any non-powder gun (NPG) device, such as an airsoft gun, not limited to: BB gun, pellet gun, spot marker gun, paint ball gun, taser gun, or stun gun.
